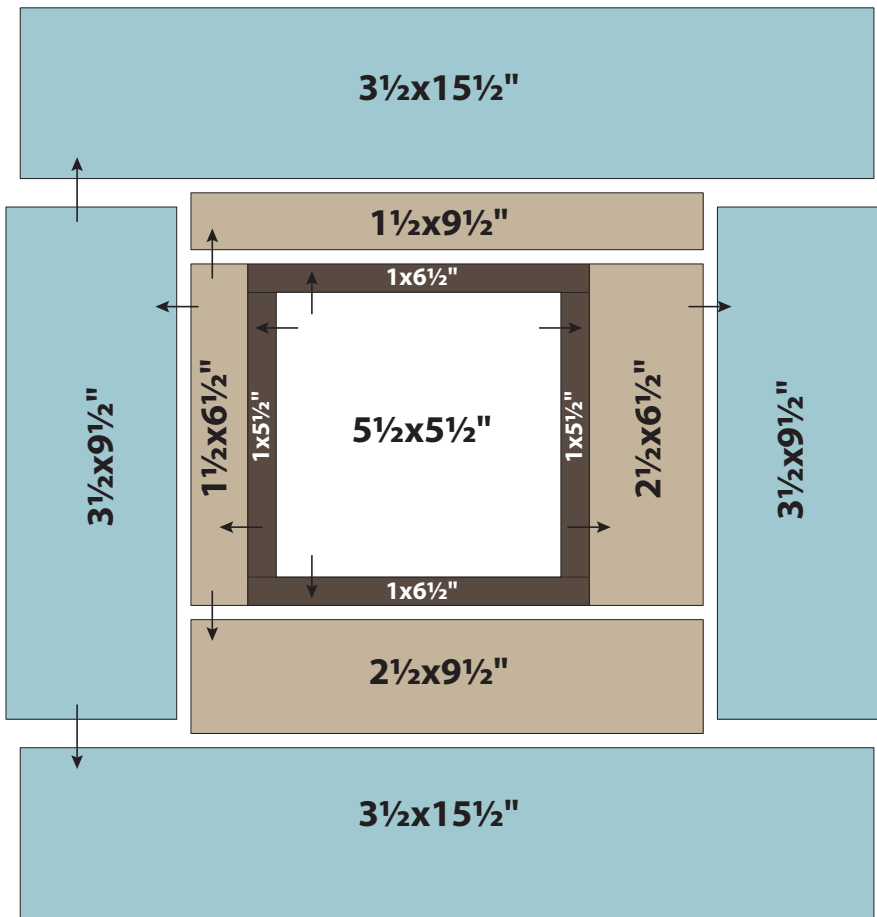


The Big Day Quilt

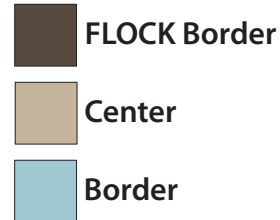
5x5" FLOCK Block

Block Finished Size 15x15"

Unfinished measurements are shown in the illustration



Fabrics and Cutting



Note that the "Center" and "Border" fabrics may be reversed based on the location of the block within the quilt setting.

Directional fabrics are not recommended.

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x6½" strips and two 1x5½" strips

Center (3x42")

- Cut one 2½x9½" strip, one 2½x6½" strip, one 1½x9½" strip, and one 1½x6½" strip

Border (8x42")

- Cut two 3½x9½" strips, and two 3½x15½" strips

FLOCK Block used for the 5x5" setting:

- Hummingbird Bonus Block

Piecing

Note: Based on the orientation of the FLOCK block in the setting, 'sides,' 'top and bottom,' 'right,' and 'left' labels from the pattern may not correspond with your block. Follow the **block piecing diagram** and your shorthand notes from Step 3, page 4 carefully.

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Center

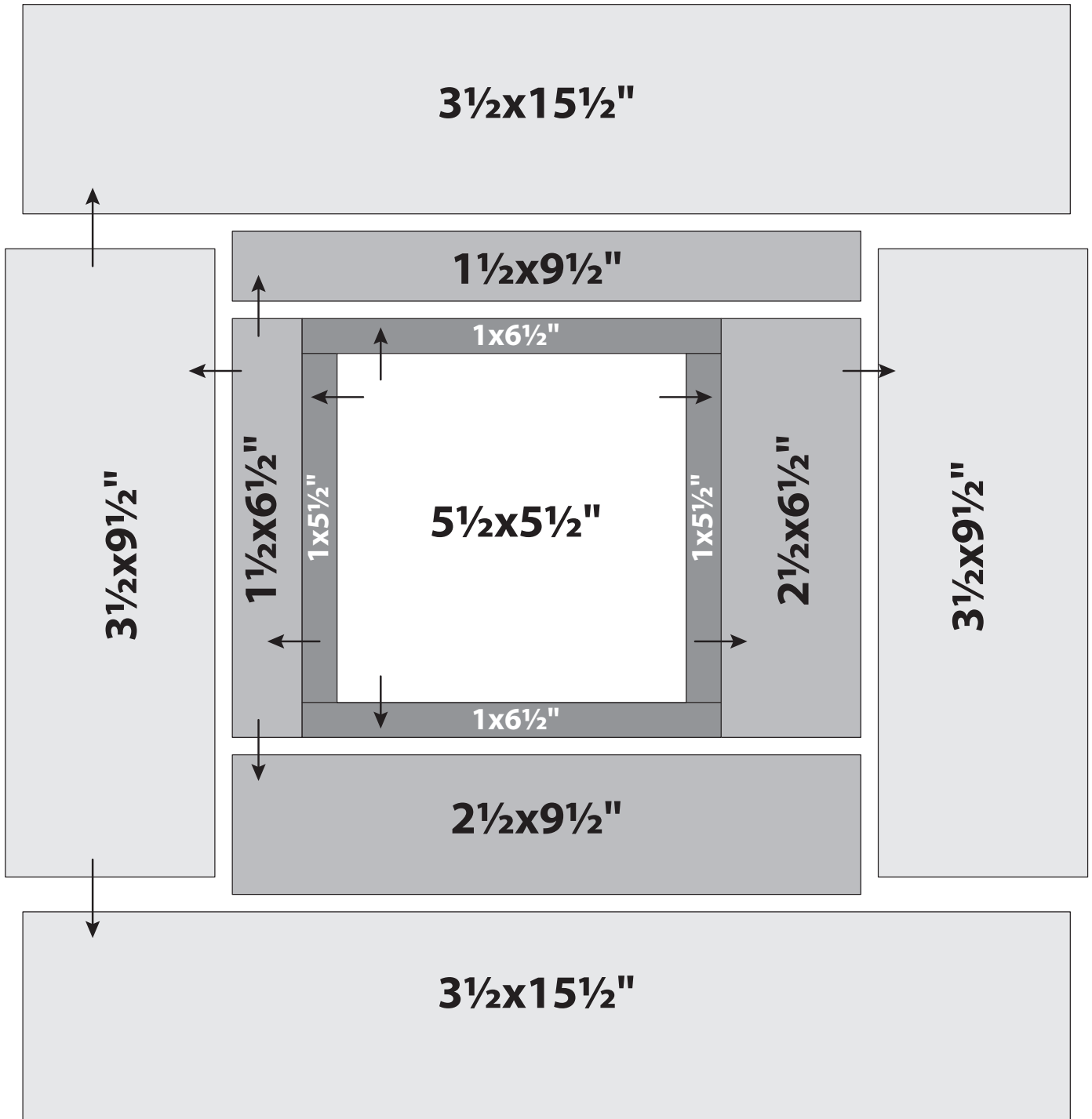
- Sew a 1x5½" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x6½" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- **The block with FLOCK borders measures 6½x6½".**
- Sew the 1½x6½" Center strip to the left side of the block and the 2½x6½" Center strip to the right side of the block.
- Sew the 1½x9½" Center strip to the top of the block and the 2½x9½" strip to the bottom of the block.

Sew the Borders and Finish the Block

- Sew a 3½x9½" Border strip to each side of the block.
- Sew a 3½x15½" Border strip to the top and the bottom of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15½x15½".

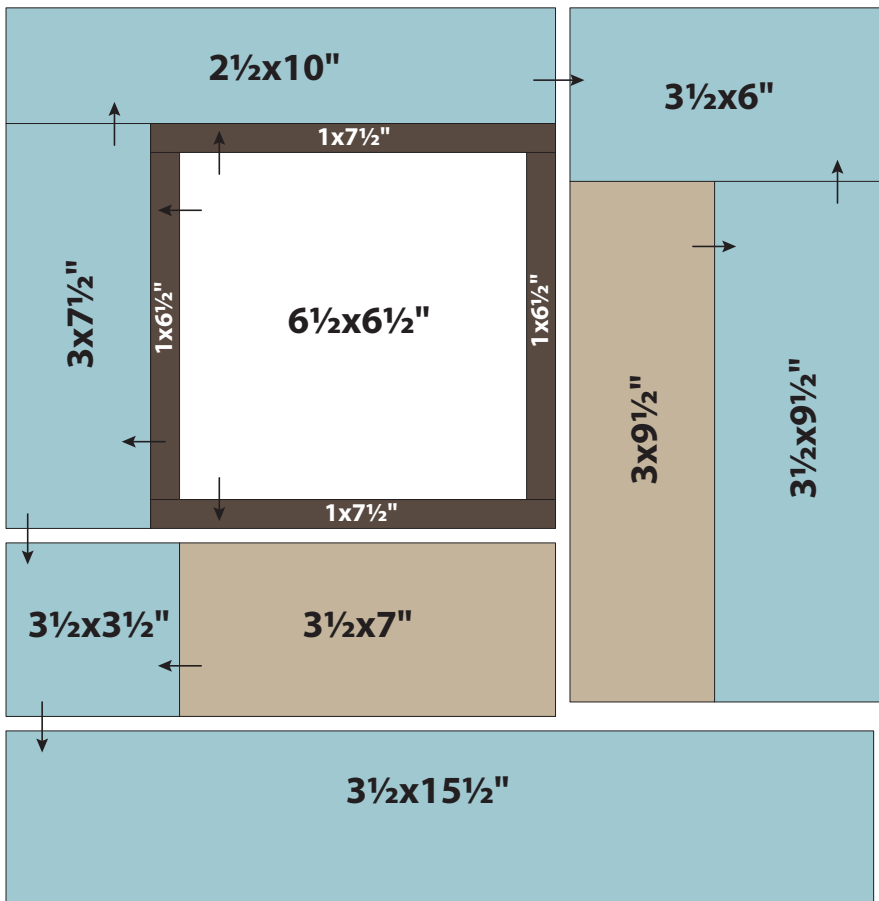

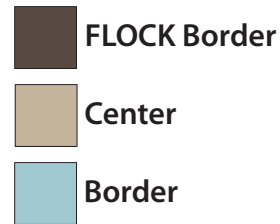
6x6" FLOCK Block

Fabrics and Cutting



Note that the "Center" and "Border" fabrics may be reversed based on the location of the block within the quilt setting.

Directional fabrics are not recommended.

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x7 1/2" strips and two 1x6 1/2" strips

Center (4x42")

- Cut one 3 1/2 x 7" strip and one 3x9 1/2" strip

Border (7x42")

- Cut one 3 1/2 x 15 1/2" strip, one 3 1/2 x 9 1/2" strip, one 3 1/2 x 6" strip, and one 3 1/2" square
- Cut one 3x7 1/2" strip and one 2 1/2 x 10" strip

FLOCK Blocks used for the 6x6" setting:

- Black-capped Chickadee
- Blackburnian Warbler
- Purple Finch
- Red-breasted Nuthatch
- Splendid Fairywren
- Yellow Warbler

Piecing

Note: Based on the orientation of the FLOCK block in the setting, 'sides,' 'top and bottom,' 'right,' and 'left' labels from the pattern may not correspond with your block. Follow the **block piecing diagram** and your shorthand notes from Step 3, page 4 carefully.

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Upper Left Corner

- Sew a 1x6 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x7 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 7 1/2 x 7 1/2".
- Sew the 3x7 1/2" Border strip to the left side of the block.
- Sew the 2 1/2 x 10" Border strip to the top of the block. Set aside.
- Sew the 3 1/2" Border square to the left of the 3 1/2 x 7" Center strip as shown; press toward the square.
- Sew the border/center strip to the bottom of the block assembly.

Sew the Upper Right Corner

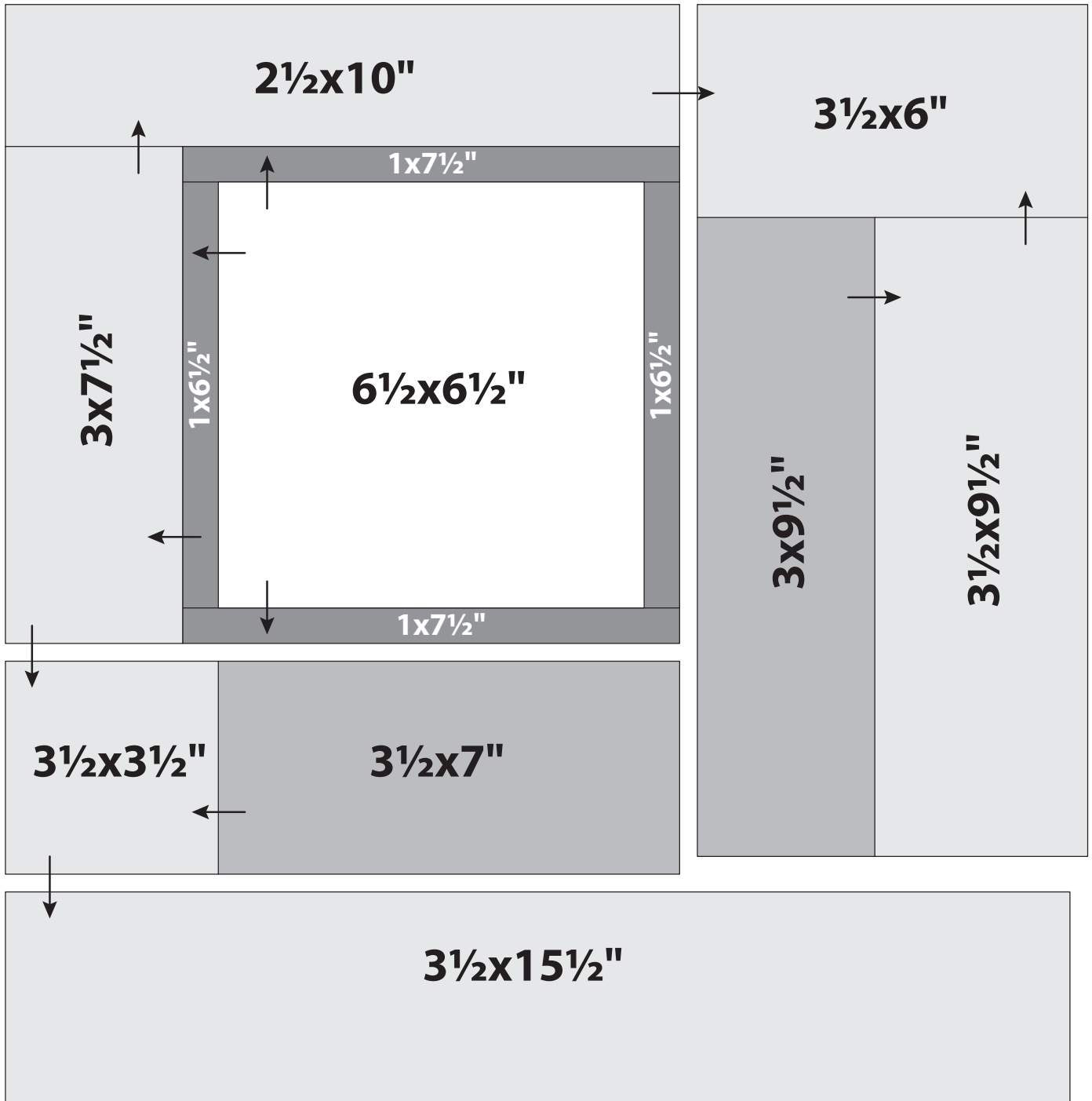
- Sew the 3x9 1/2" Center strip to the left of the 3 1/2 x 9 1/2" Border strip; press toward the block border strip.
- Sew the 3 1/2 x 6" Border strip to the top of the center/border assembly.

Finish the Block

- Sew the center/border assembly to the right of the block.
- Sew the 3 1/2 x 15 1/2" Border strip to the bottom of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15 1/2 x 15 1/2".

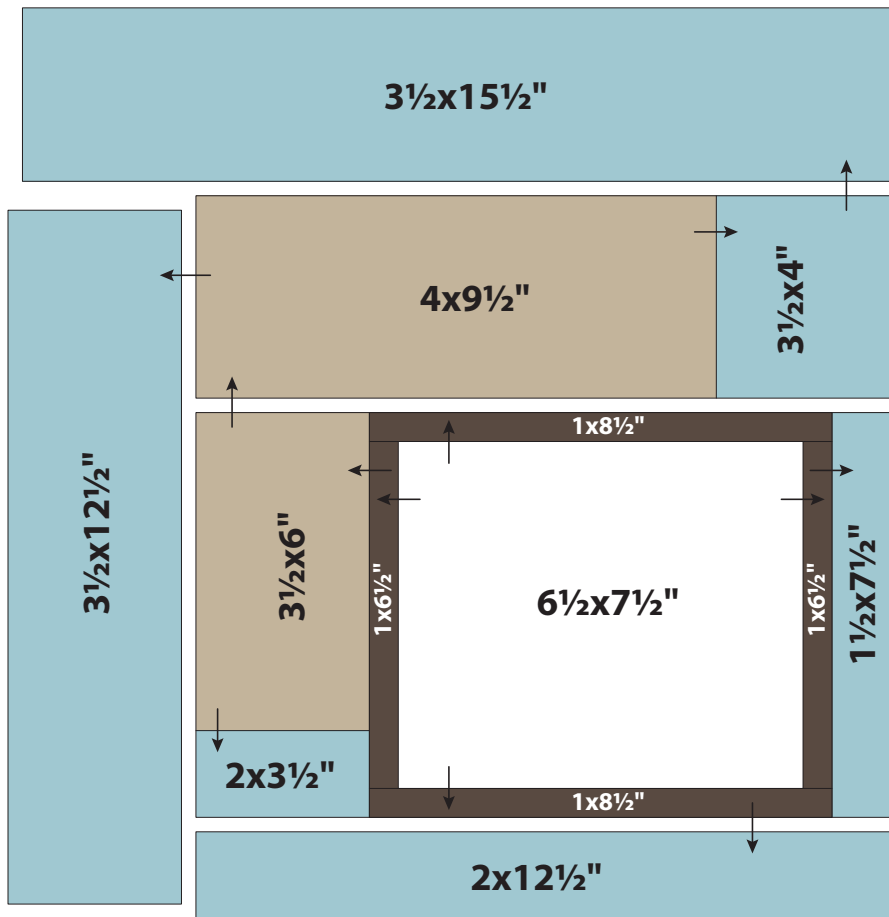

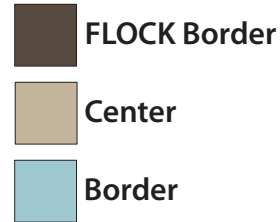
6x7" FLOCK Block

Fabrics and Cutting

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x8 1/2" strips and two 1x6 1/2" strips

Center (5x42")

- Cut one 4x9 1/2" strip and one 3 1/2x6" rectangle

Border (6x42")

- Cut one 3 1/2x15 1/2" strip, one 3 1/2x12 1/2" strip, and one 3 1/2x4" rectangle
- Cut one 2x12 1/2" strip, one 2x3 1/2" rectangle, and one 1 1/2x7 1/2" strip

FLOCK Block used for the 6x7" setting:

- European Robin

Piecing

Note: Based on the orientation of the FLOCK block in the setting, 'sides,' 'top and bottom,' 'right,' and 'left' labels from the pattern may not correspond with your block. Follow the **block piecing diagram** and your shorthand notes from Step 3, page 4 carefully.

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Block Borders

- Sew a 1x6 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x8 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 7 1/2x8 1/2".
- Sew the 1 1/2x7 1/2" Border strip to the right side of the block. Set aside.
- Sew the 2x3 1/2" Border rectangle to the bottom of the 3 1/2x6" Center rectangle; press toward the border strip.

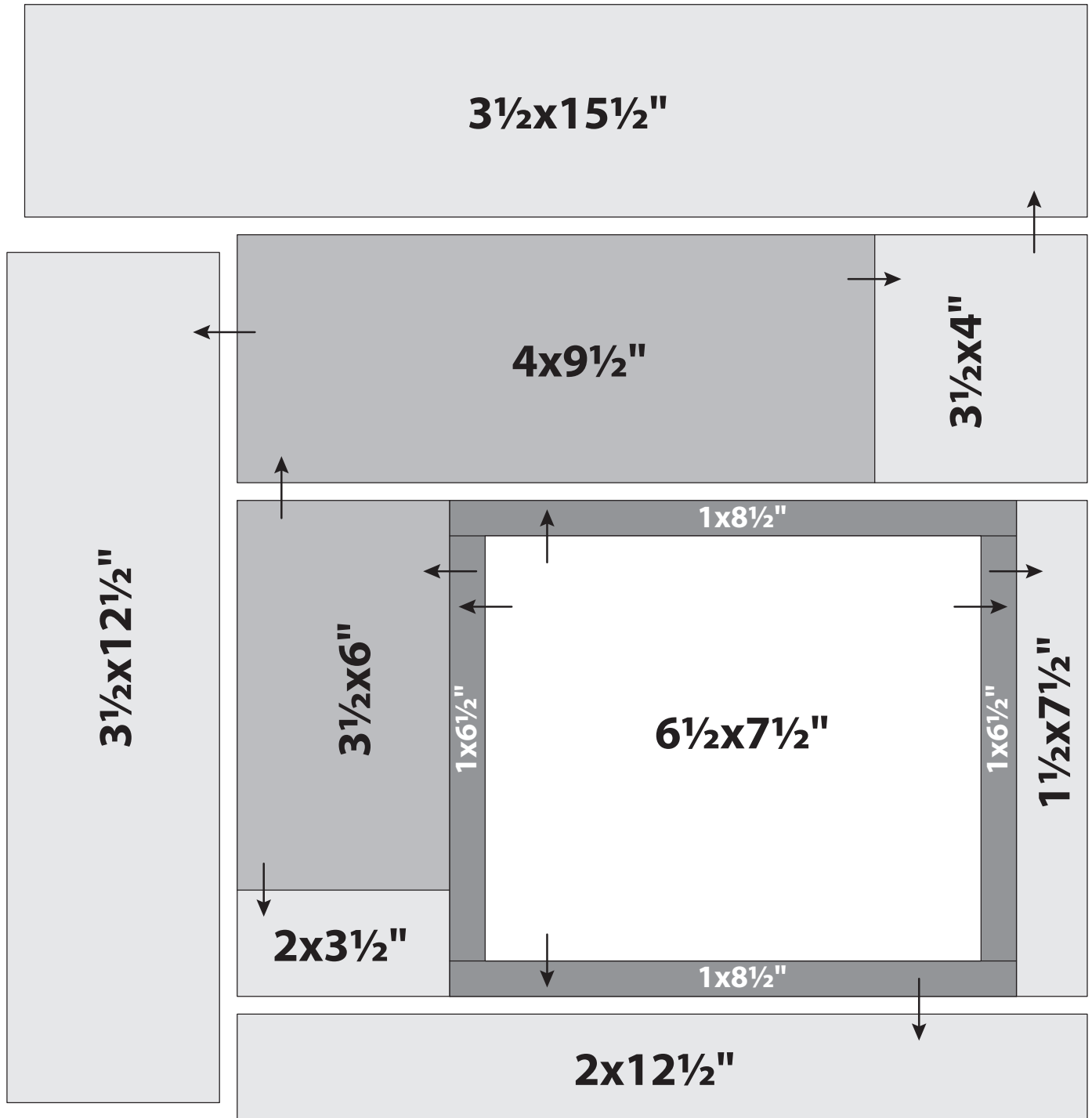
- Sew the center/border assembly to the left side of the block.
- Sew the 2x12 1/2" Border strip to the bottom of the block. Set aside.
- Sew the 4x9 1/2" Center strip to the left of the 3 1/2x4" Border rectangle; press toward the border rectangle.
- Sew the upper center/border assembly to the top of the block.

Finish the Block

- Sew the 3 1/2x12 1/2" Border strip to the left of the block.
- Sew the 3 1/2x15 1/2" Border strip to the top of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15 1/2x15 1/2".

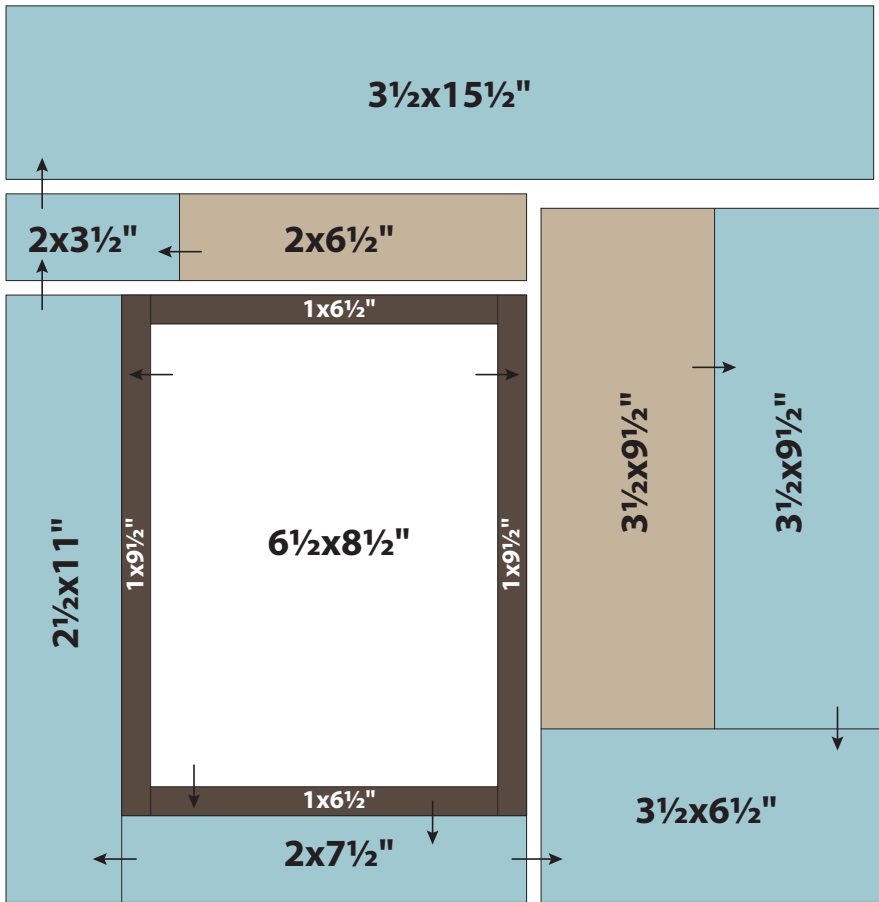

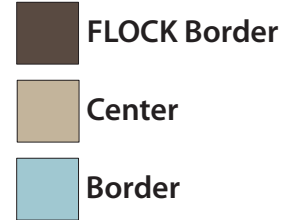

Fabrics and Cutting

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x9½" strips and two 1x6½" strips

Center (4x42")

- Cut one 3½x9½" strip and one 2x6½" strip

Border (7x42")

- Cut one 3½x15½" strip, one 3½x9½" strip, and one 3½x6½" strip
- Cut one 2½x11" strip, one 2x7½" strip, and one 2x3½" strip

FLOCK Block used for the 6x8" setting:

- Hairy Woodpecker

Piecing

Note: Based on the orientation of the FLOCK block in the setting, 'sides,' 'top and bottom,' 'right,' and 'left' labels from the pattern may not correspond with your block. Follow the **block piecing diagram** and your shorthand notes from Step 3, page 4 carefully.

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Lower Left Corner

- Sew a 1x6½" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x9½" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- **The block with FLOCK borders measures 7½x9½".**
- Sew the 2x7½" Border strip to the bottom of the block assembly.
- Sew the 2½x11" Border strip to the left side of the block assembly. Set aside.

- Sew the 2x3½" Border strip to the left of the 2x6½" Center strip as shown; press toward the Border strip.
- Sew the 2" wide border/center strip to the top of the block assembly.

Sew the Lower Right Corner

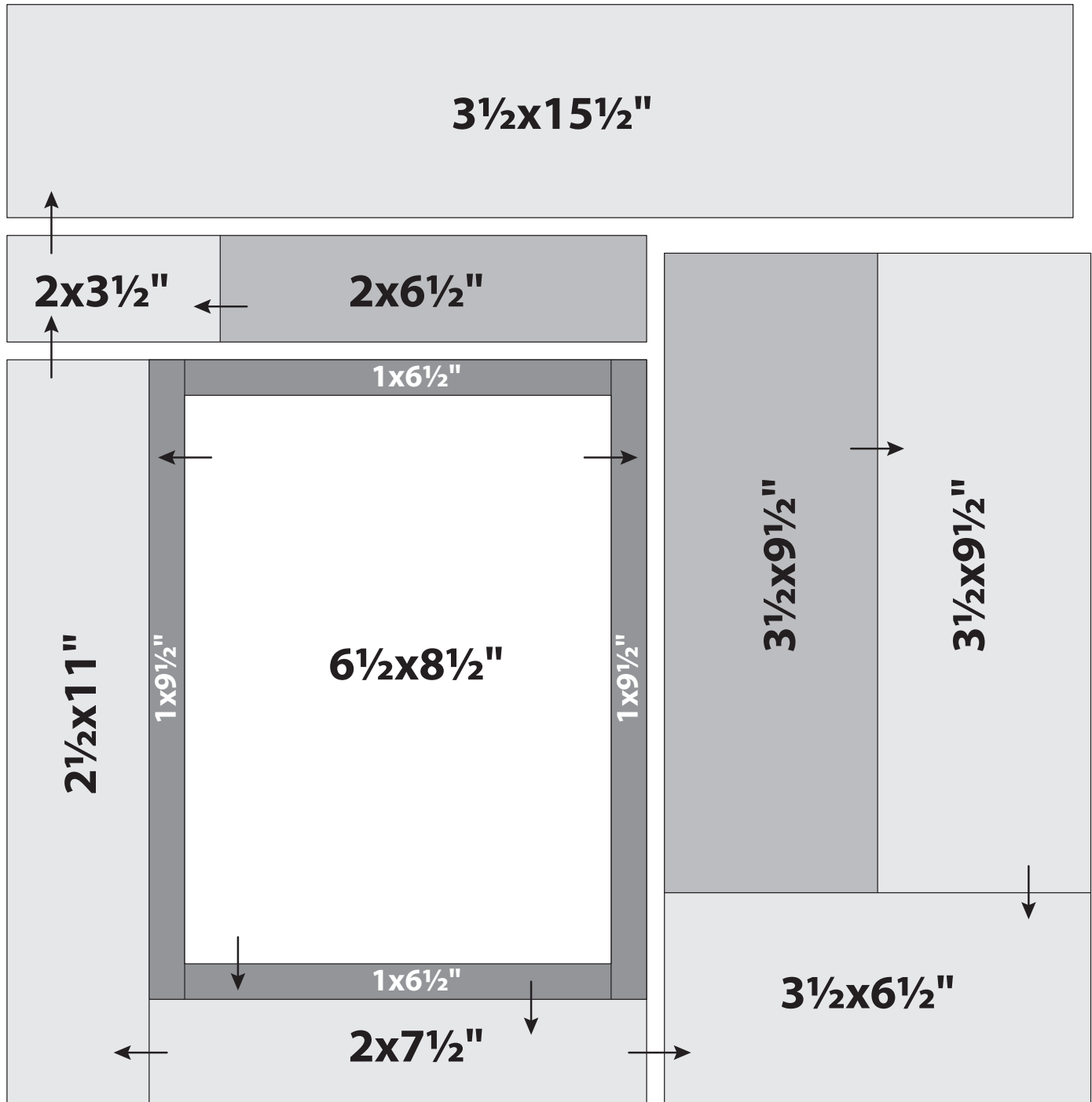
- Sew the 3½x9½" Center strip to the left of the 3½x9½" Border strip; press toward the Border strip.
- Sew the 3½x6½" Border strip to the bottom of the center/border strip-set.

Finish the Block

- Sew the center/border assembly to the right of the block assembly.
- Sew the 3½x15½" Border strip to the top of the block assembly.
- The Quilt Block measures 15½x15½".

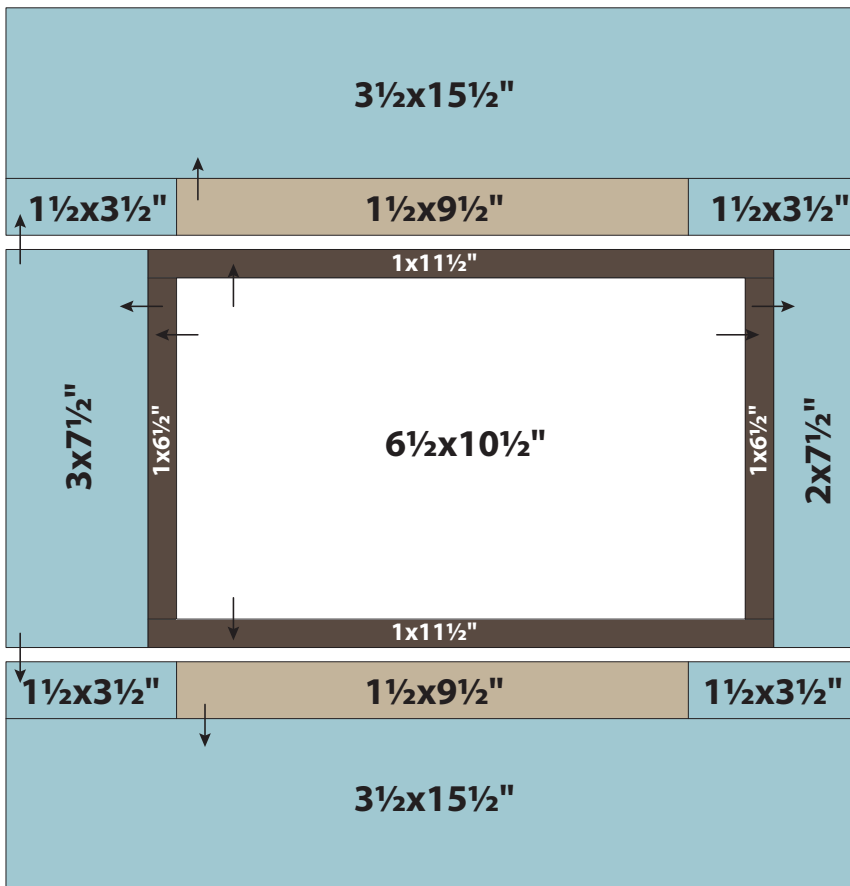

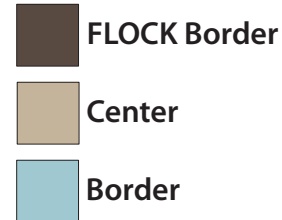

Fabrics and Cutting

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x11 1/2" strips and two 1x6 1/2" strips

Center (4x42")

- Cut one 3x9 1/2" strip

Border (7x42")

- Cut two 3 1/2 x 15 1/2" strips
- Cut one 3x7 1/2" strip, two 3x3 1/2" rectangles, and one 2x7 1/2" strip

FLOCK Block used for the 6x10" setting:

- Dark-eyed Junco

Piecing

Note: Based on the orientation of the FLOCK block in the setting, 'sides,' 'top and bottom,' 'right,' and 'left' labels from the pattern may not correspond with your block. Follow the **block piecing diagram** and your shorthand notes from Step 3, page 4 carefully.

Important:

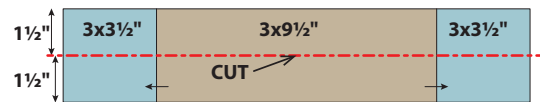
- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Sides

- Sew a 1x6 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x11 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 7 1/2 x 11 1/2".
- Sew the 3x7 1/2" Border strip to the left side of the block.
- Sew the 2x7 1/2" Border strip to the right side of the block.

Sew the Top and Bottom

- Sew a 3x3 1/2" Border rectangle to each end of the 3x9 1/2" Center strip as shown below. Cut the strip set in half lengthwise to make two border/center/border units, 1 1/2 x 15 1/2".



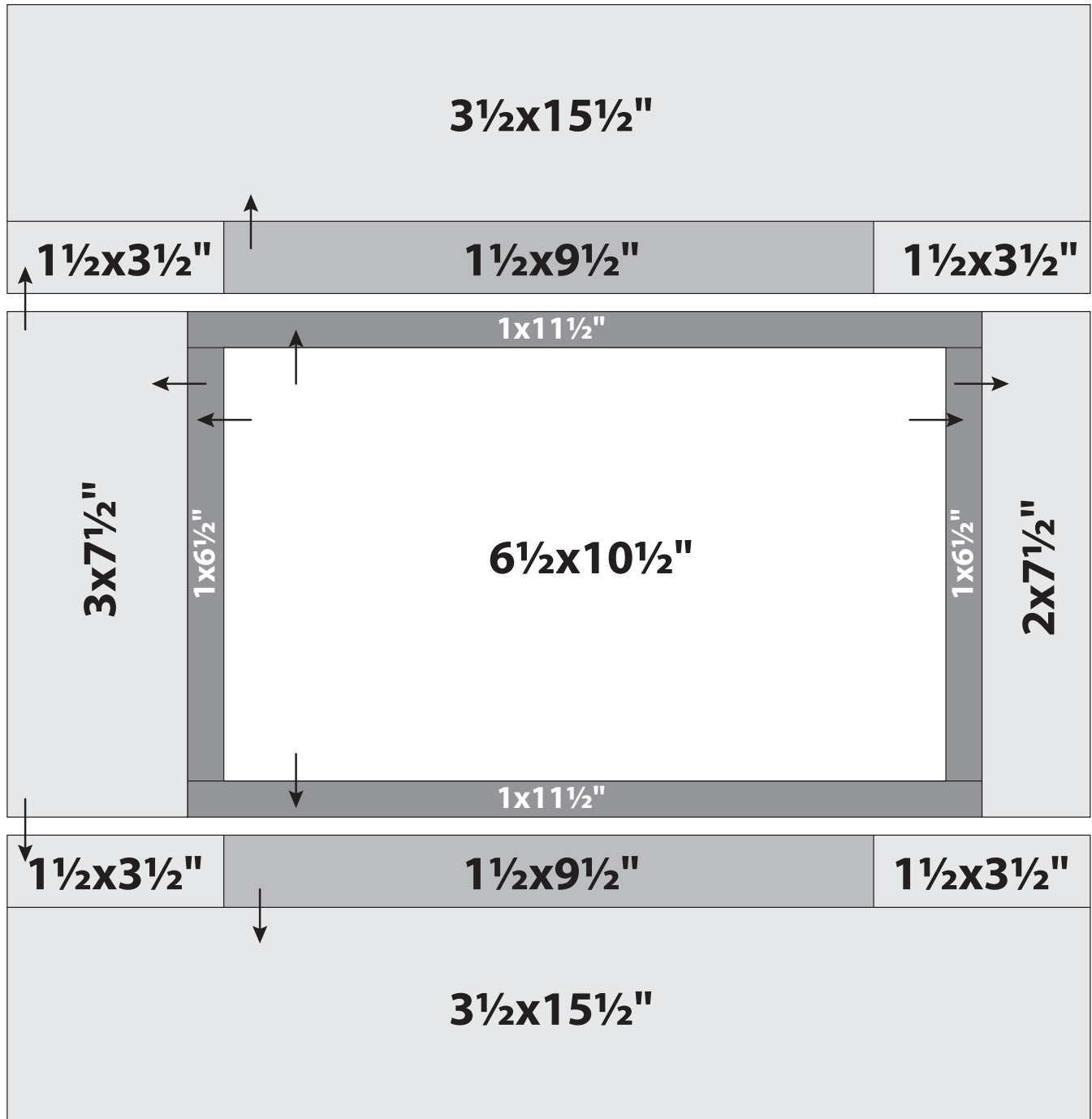
- Sew a 3 1/2 x 15 1/2" Border strip to the top of one border/center/border unit, and sew a 3 1/2 x 15 1/2" border strip to the bottom of the other Border/Center/Border unit.

Finish the Block

- Sew the top and bottom assemblies to the top and bottom of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15 1/2 x 15 1/2".

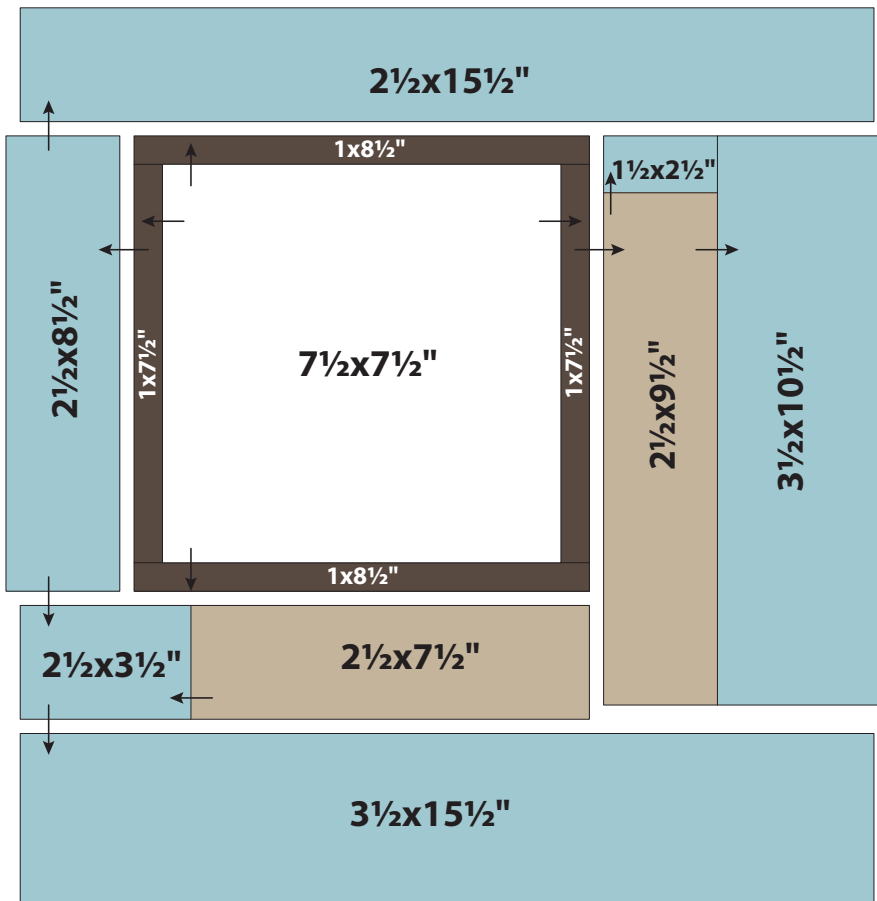

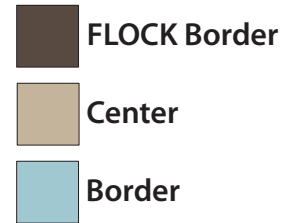
7x7" FLOCK Block

Fabrics and Cutting

Directional fabrics are not recommended.

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x8½" strips and two 1x7½" strips

Center (3x42")

- Cut one 2½x9½" strip and one 2½x7½" strip

Border (7x42")

- Cut one 3½x15½" strip and one 3½x10½" strip
- Cut one 2½x15½" strip, one 2½x8½" strip, one 2½x3½" rectangle and one 1½x2½" rectangle

FLOCK Blocks used for the 7x7" setting:

- American Redstart
- American Robin's Nest
- Common Nightingale
- Piping Plover
- Western Tanager
- Wood Thrush

Piecing

Note: Based on the orientation of the FLOCK block in the setting, 'sides,' 'top and bottom,' 'right,' and 'left' labels from the pattern may not correspond with your block. Follow the **block piecing diagram** and your shorthand notes from Step 3, page 4 carefully.

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Left Elements

- Sew a 1x7½" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x8½" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 8½x8½".
- Sew the 2½x8½" Border strip to the left side of the block. Set aside.
- Sew the 2½x3½" Border rectangle to the left of the 2½x7½" Center strip as shown. Press toward the Border rectangle.

- Sew the center/border strip assembly to the bottom of the block.

Sew the Right Side, Top, and Bottom

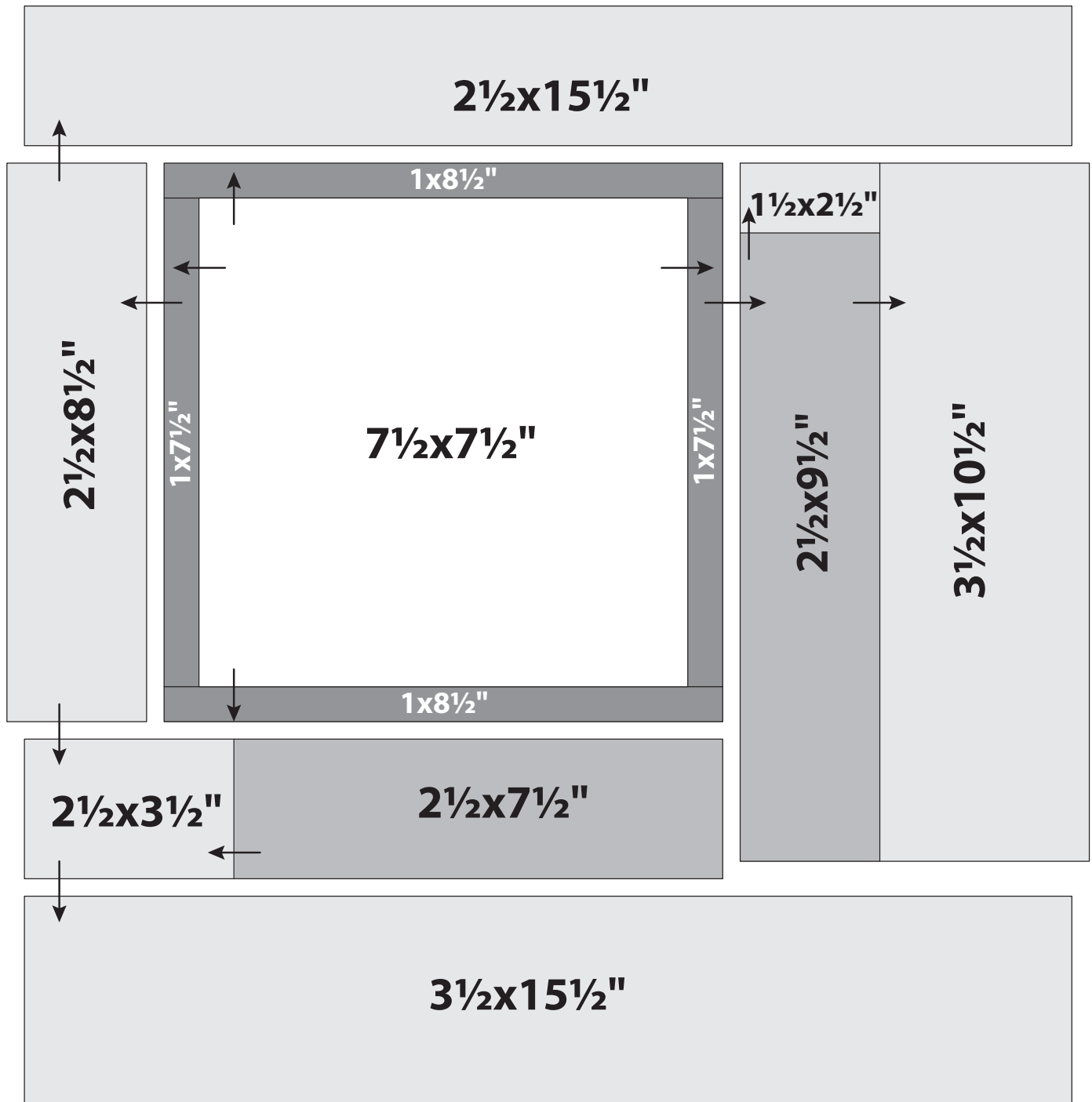
- Sew a 1½x2½" Border rectangle to the top of the 2½x9½" Center strip as shown. Press toward the Border rectangle.
- Sew the 3½x10½" Border strip to the right of the center/border side strip.

Finish the Block

- Sew the right side assembly to the right of the block.
- Sew the 2½x15½" Border strip to the top of the block and the 3½x15½" Border strip to the bottom of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15½x15½".

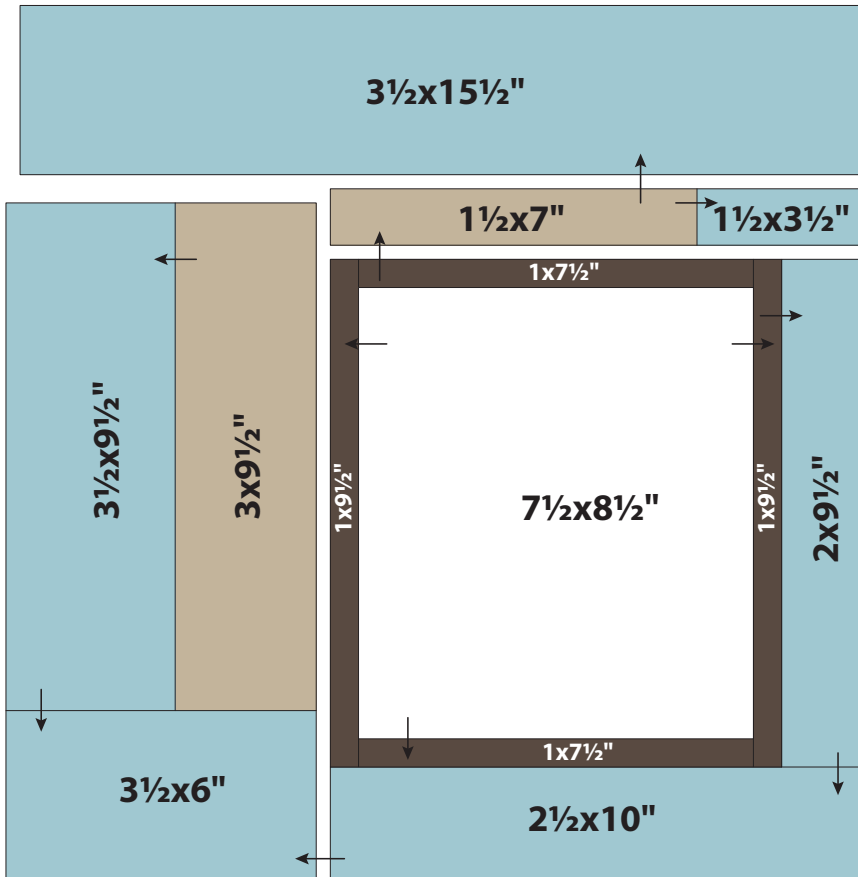

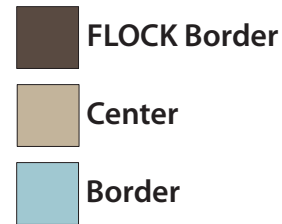

Fabrics and Cutting

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x9 1/2" strips and two 1x7 1/2" strips

Center (4x42")

- Cut one 3x9 1/2" strip and one 1 1/2x7" strip

Border (7x42")

- Cut one 3 1/2x15 1/2" strip, one 3 1/2x9 1/2" strip, and one 3 1/2x6" strip
- Cut one 2 1/2x10" strip, one 2x9 1/2" strip, and one 1 1/2x3 1/2" rectangle

FLOCK Blocks used for the 7x8" setting:

- American Kestrel
- Bobolink
- Evening Grosbeak
- Red-bellied Woodpecker

Piecing

Note: Based on the orientation of the FLOCK block in the setting, 'sides,' 'top and bottom,' 'right,' and 'left' labels from the pattern may not correspond with your block. Follow the *block piecing diagram* and your shorthand notes from Step 3, page 4 carefully.

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Right Side

- Sew a 1x7 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x9 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 8 1/2x9 1/2".
- Sew the 2x9 1/2" Border strip to the right side of the block.
- Sew the 2 1/2x10" Border strip to the bottom of the block. Set aside.

- Sew the 1 1/2x7" Center strip to them left of the 1 1/2x3 1/2" Border rectangle as shown; press toward the border rectangle.
- Sew the center/border strip assembly to the top of the block.

Sew the Left Side Unit

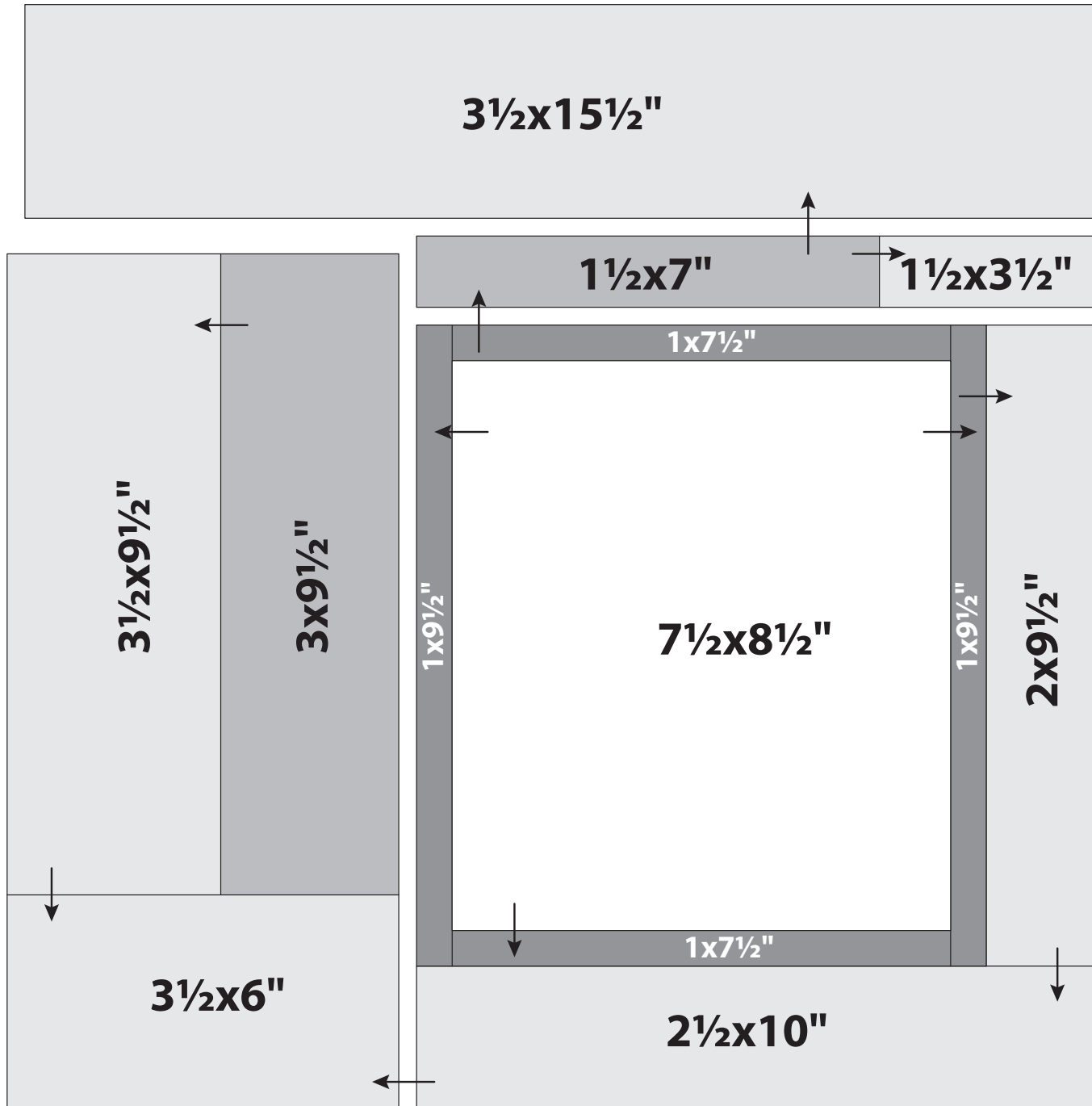
- Sew the 3x9 1/2" Center strip to the 3 1/2x9 1/2" Border strip as shown; press toward the Border strip.
- Sew the 3 1/2x6" Border strip to the bottom of the center/border strip set.

Finish the Block

- Sew the left side assembly to the block; press toward the left side assembly.
- Sew the 3 1/2x15 1/2" Border strip to the top of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15 1/2x15 1/2".

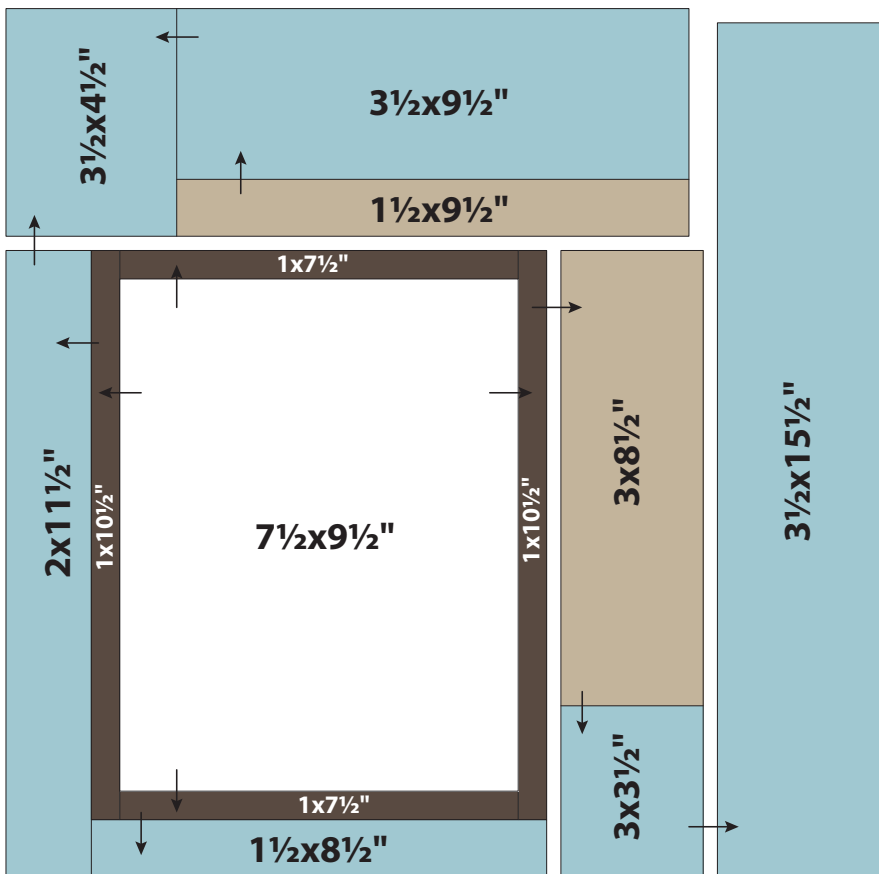

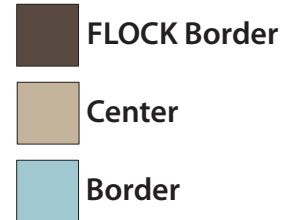
7x9" FLOCK Block

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x10½" strips and two 1x7½" strips

Center (4x42")

- Cut one 3x8½" strip and one 1½x9½" strip

Border (6x42")

- Cut one 3½x15½" strip, one 3½x9½" strip, one 3½x4½" rectangle, and one 3x3½" rectangle
- Cut one 2x11½" strip and one 1½x8½" strip

FLOCK Blocks used for the 7x9" setting:

- Barn Owl
- Burrowing Owl
- Green Heron

Piecing

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Lower Borders

- Sew a 1x7½" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x10½" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 8½x10½".
- Sew the 1½x8½" Border strip to the bottom of the block.
- Sew the 2x11½" Border strip to the left of the block. Set aside.

- Sew the 3x3½" Border rectangle to the bottom of the 3x8½" Center strip as shown; press toward the border rectangle.

- Sew the center/border assembly to the right of the block.

Sew the Top

- Sew the 1½x9½" Center strip to the 3½x9½" Border strip; press toward the border strip.
- Sew the 3½x4½" Border rectangle to the left of the center/border strip set.

Finish the Block

- Sew the top assembly to the top of the block.
- Sew the 3½x15½" Border strip to the right of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15½x15½".
