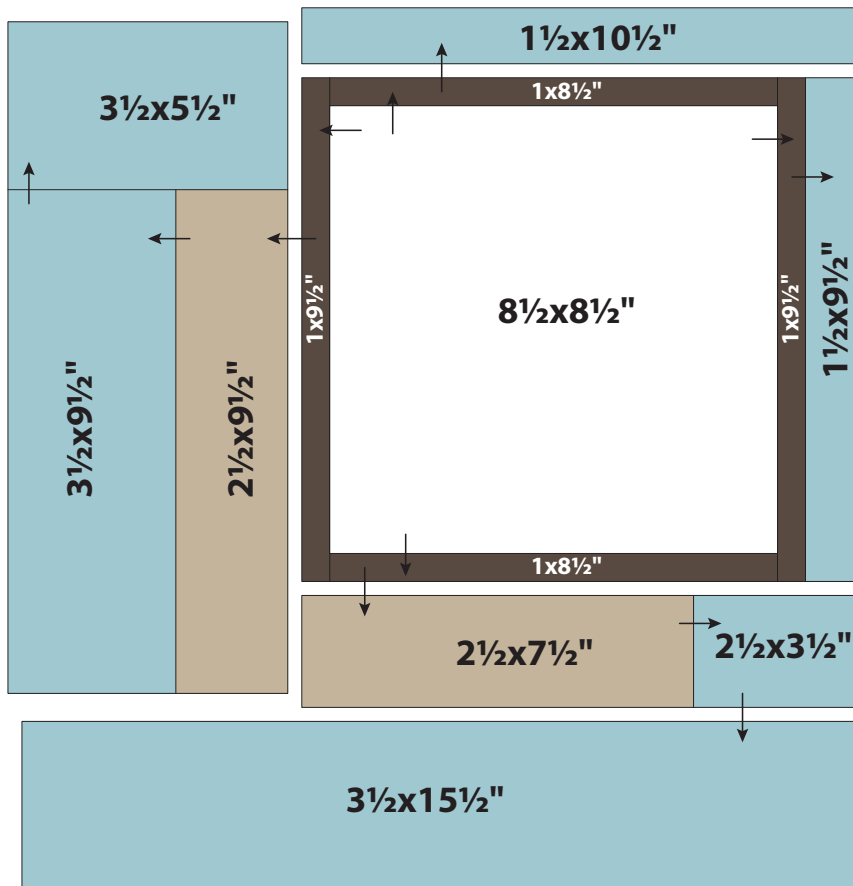


The Big Day Quilt

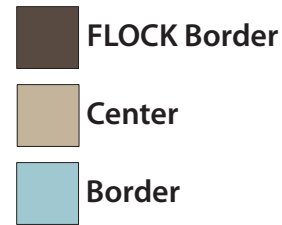
8x8" FLOCK Block

Block Finished Size 15x15"

Unfinished measurements are shown in the illustration



Fabrics and Cutting



Note that the "Center" and "Border" fabrics may be reversed based on the location of the block within the quilt setting.

Directional fabrics are not recommended.

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x9 1/2" strips and two 1x8 1/2" strips

Center (3x42")

- Cut one 2 1/2x9 1/2" strip and one 2 1/2x7 1/2" strip

Border (5x42")

- Cut one 3 1/2x15 1/2" strip, one 3 1/2x9 1/2" strip, one 3x5 1/2" rectangle, and one 2 1/2x3 1/2" rectangle
- Cut one 1 1/2x10 1/2" strip and one 1 1/2x9 1/2" strip

Piecing

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Upper Right Borders

- Sew a 1x8 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x9 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 9 1/2x9 1/2".
- Sew the 1 1/2x9 1/2" Border strip to the right side of the block.
- Sew the 1 1/2x10 1/2" Border strip to the top of the block. Set aside.
- Sew the 2 1/2x7 1/2" Center strip to the left of the 2 1/2x3 1/2" Border rectangle; press toward the border rectangle.
- Sew the center/border strip to the bottom of the block.

Sew the Left Side

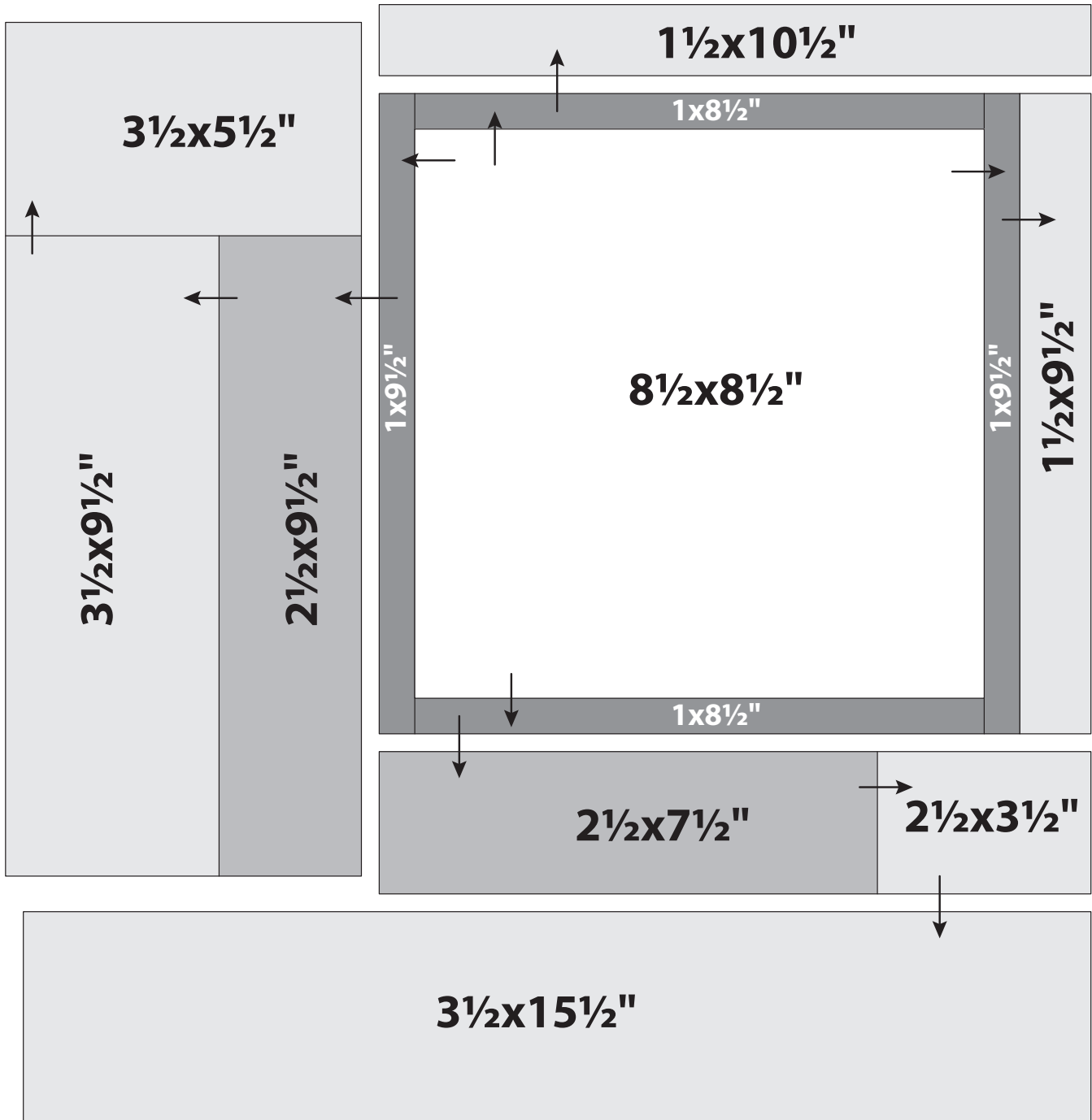
- Sew the 2 1/2x9 1/2" Center strip to the right of the 3 1/2x9 1/2" Border strip; press toward the border strip.
- Sew the 3 1/2x5 1/2" Border strip to the top of the center/border strip set.

Finish the Block

- Sew the left side assembly to the left of the block.
- Sew the 3 1/2x15 1/2" Border strip to the bottom of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15 1/2x15 1/2".

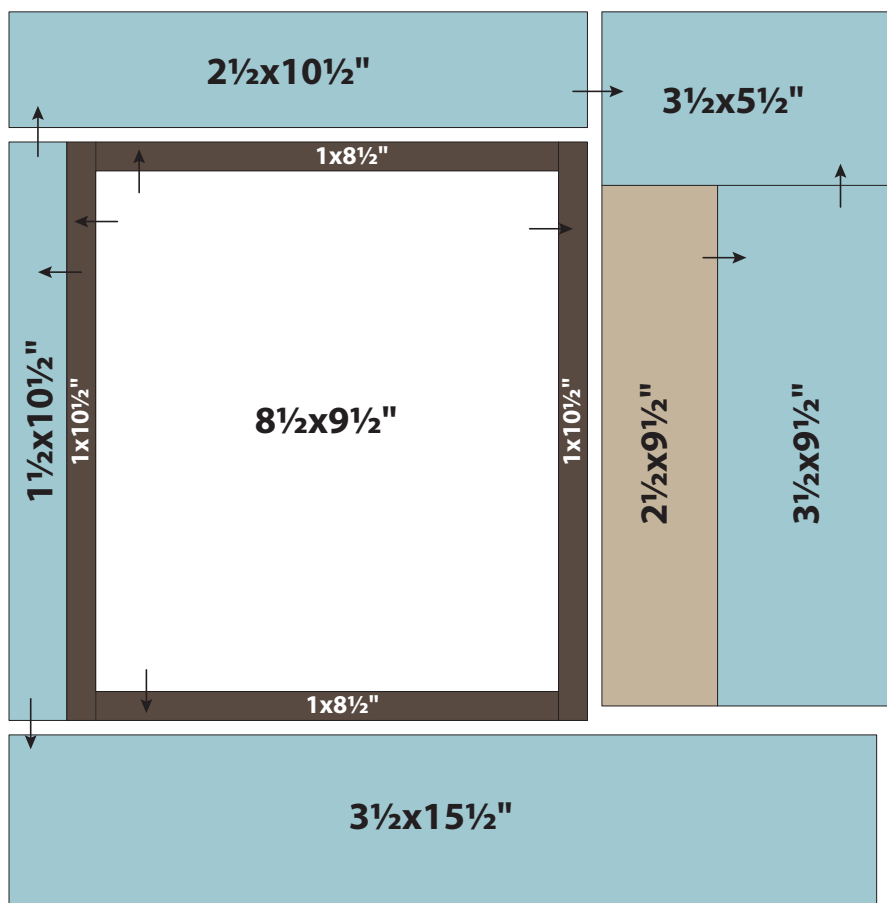

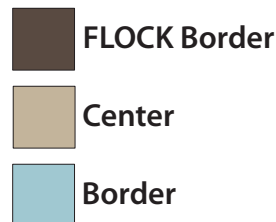
8x9" FLOCK Block

Fabrics and Cutting

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x10½" strips and two 1x8½" strips

Center (3x42")

- Cut one 2½x9½" strip

Border (7x42")

- Cut one 3½x15½" strip, one 3½x9½" strip, and one 3½x5½" rectangle
- Cut one 2½x10½" strip and one 1½x10½" strip

FLOCK Block used for the 8x9" setting:

- Pileated Woodpecker

Piecing

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Upper Left Borders

- Sew a 1x8½" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x10½" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 9½x10½".
- Sew the 1½x10½" Border strip to the left side of the block.
- Sew the 2½x10½" Border strip to the top of the block.

Sew the Upper Right Borders

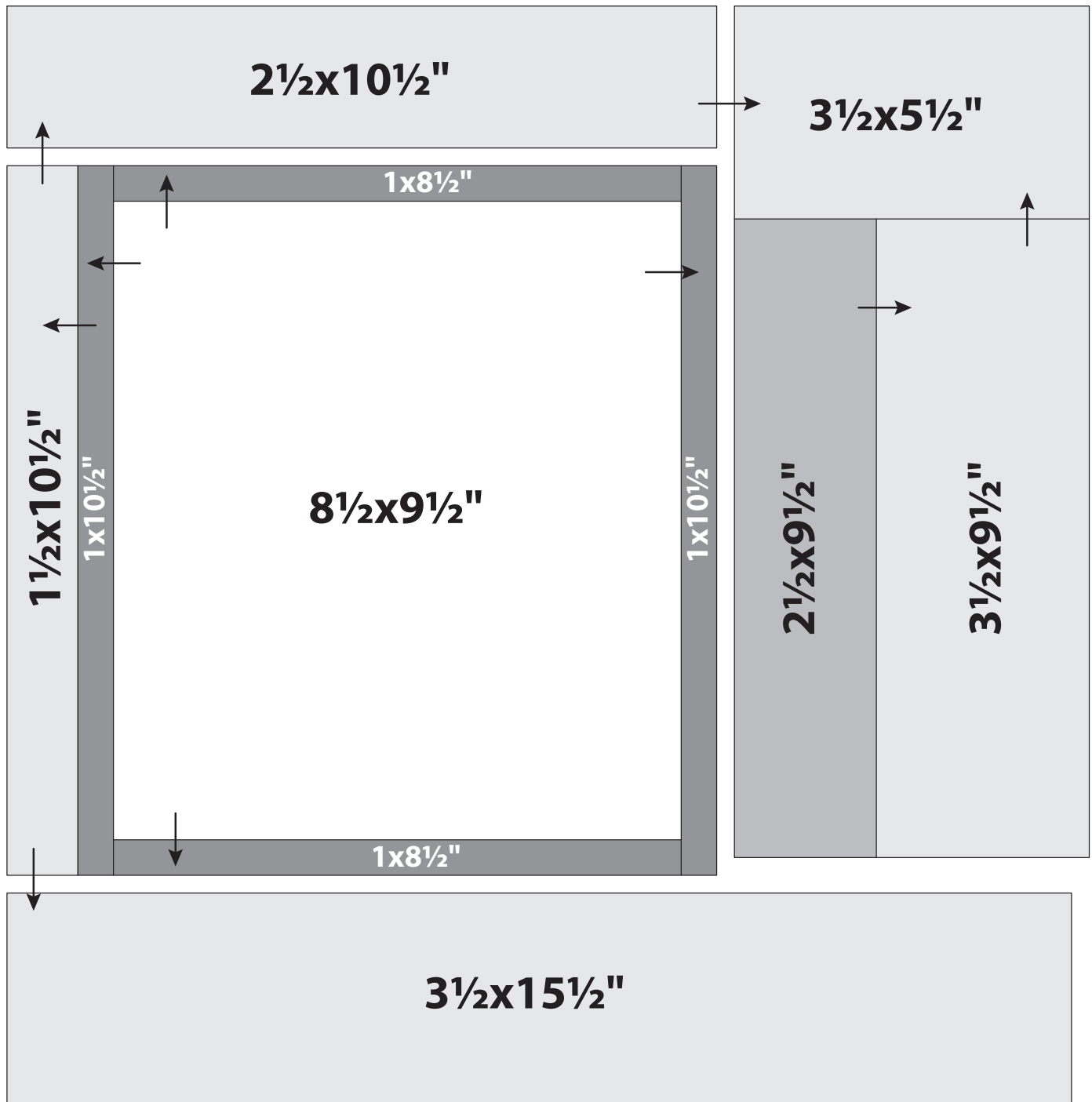
- Sew the 2½x9½" Center strip to the left of the 3½x9½" Border strip; press toward the border strip.
- Sew the 3½x5½" Border rectangle to the top of the center/ border strip set.

Finish the Block

- Sew the upper right assembly to the block, press toward the upper right assembly.
- Sew the 3½x15½" Border strip to the bottom of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15½x15½".

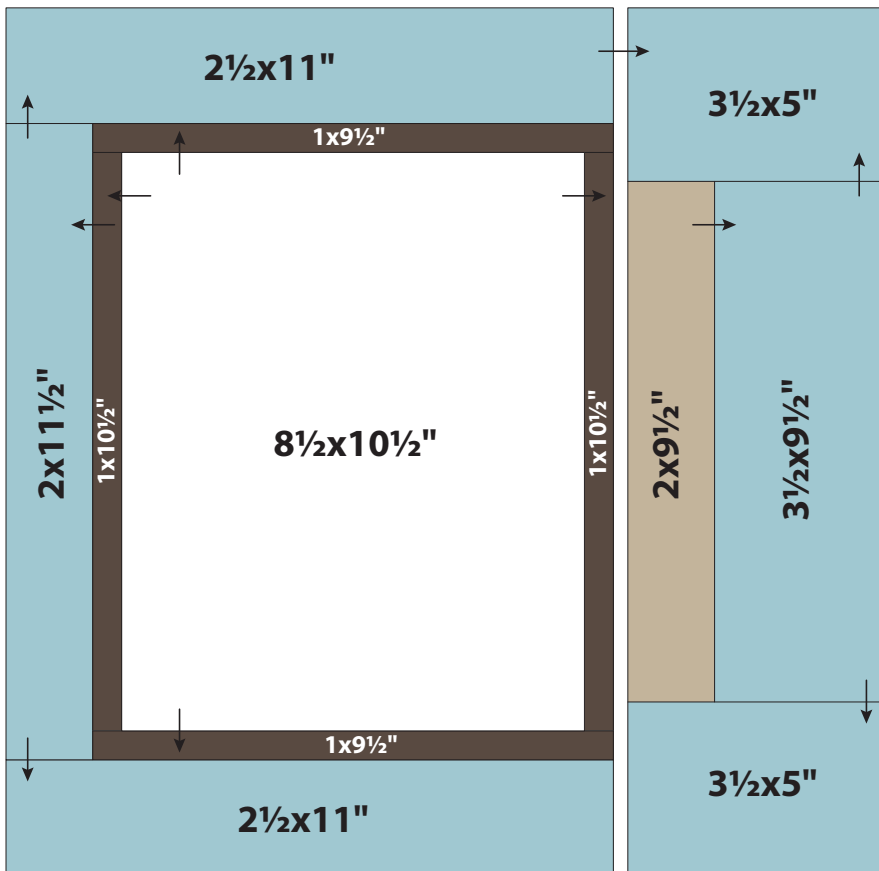

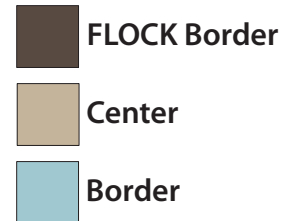

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x10½" strips and two 1x9½" strips

Center (3x42")

- Cut one 2x9½" strip

Border (7x42")

- Cut one 3½x9½" strip and two 3½x5" rectangles
- Cut two 2½x11" strips and one 2x11½" strip

FLOCK Blocks used for the 8x10" setting:

- Common Loon
- Laughing Gull
- Peregrine Falcon
- Southern Rockhopper Penguin

Piecing

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Left Side

- Sew a 1x10½" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x9½" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 9½x11½".
- Sew the 2x11½" Border strip to the left side of the block.
- Sew a 2½x11" Border strip to the top and bottom of the block.

Sew the Right Side

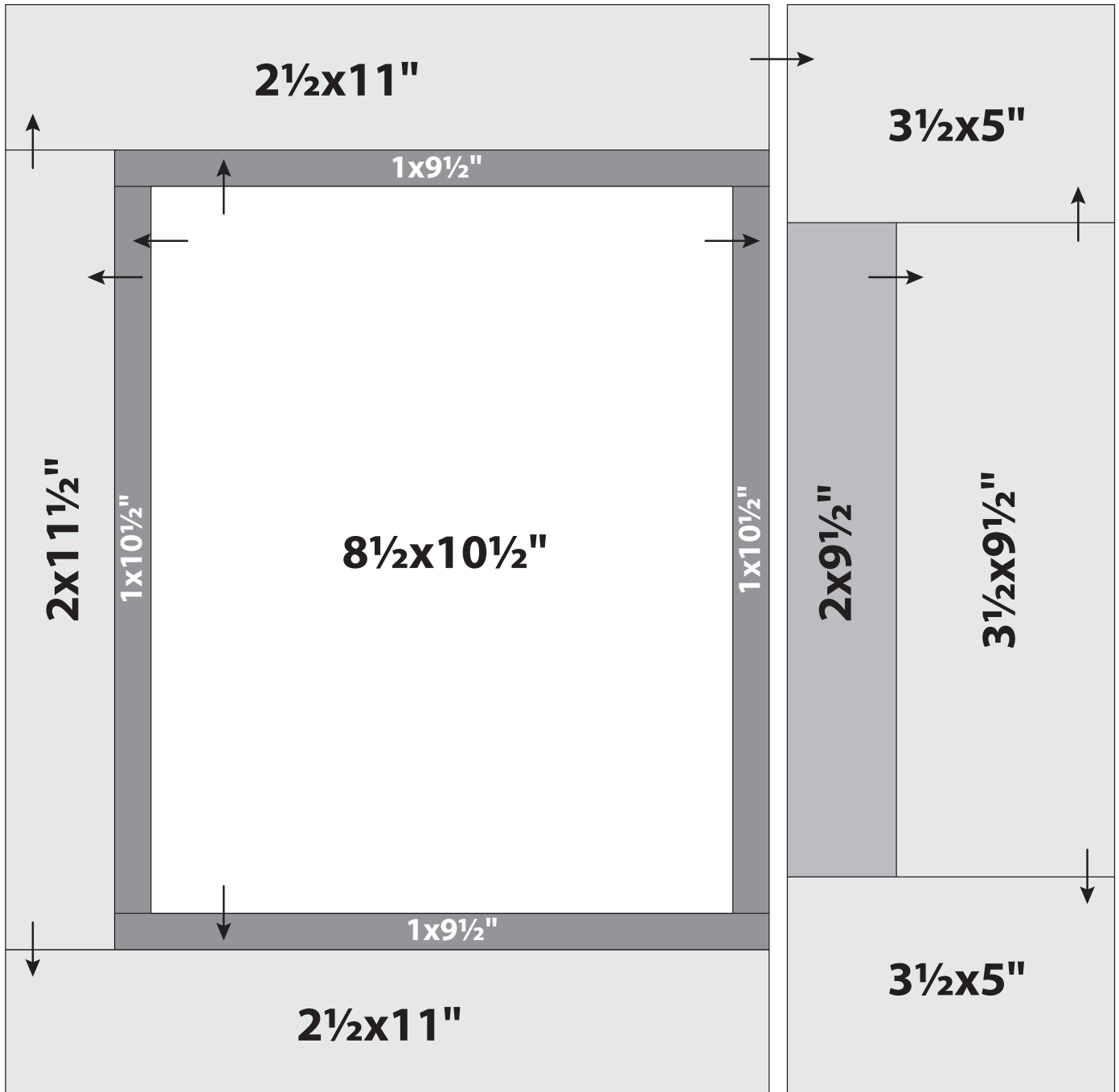
- Sew the 2x9½" Center strip to the left of the 3½x9½" Border strip; press toward the border strip.
- Sew a 3½x5" Border rectangle to the top and bottom of the of the center/border strip set.

Finish the Block

- Sew the right side assembly to the block; press toward the right side assembly.
- The Quilt Block measures 15½x15½".

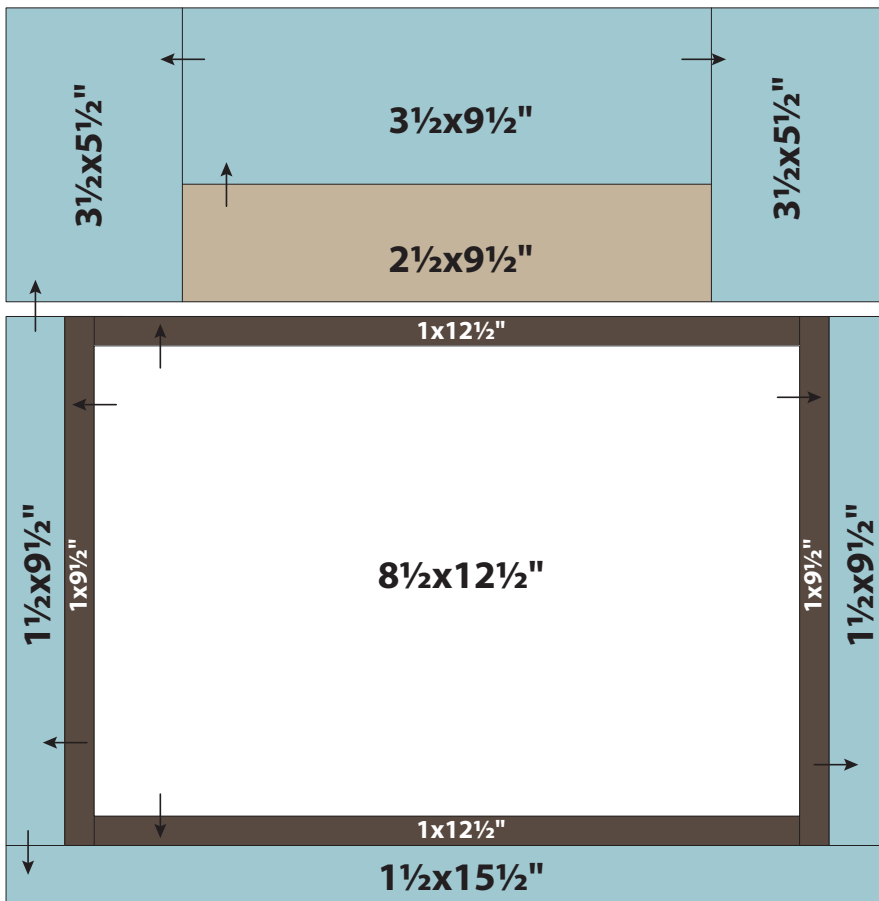

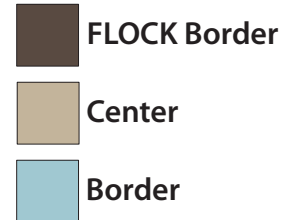
8x12" FLOCK Block

FLOCK Border (3x42")

- Cut two 1x12½" strips and two 1x9½" strips

Center (3x42")

- Cut one 2½x9½" strip

Border (6x42")

- Cut one 3½x9½" strip and two 3½x5½" rectangles
- Cut one 1½x15½" strip and two 1½x9½" strips

FLOCK Block used for the 8x12"

setting:

- Scissor-tailed Flycatcher

Piecing

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Lower Block

- Sew a 1x12½" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x9½" Block Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 9½x13½".
- Sew a 1½x9½" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the block.
- Sew the 1½x15½" Border strip to the bottom of the block assembly.

Sew the Upper Borders

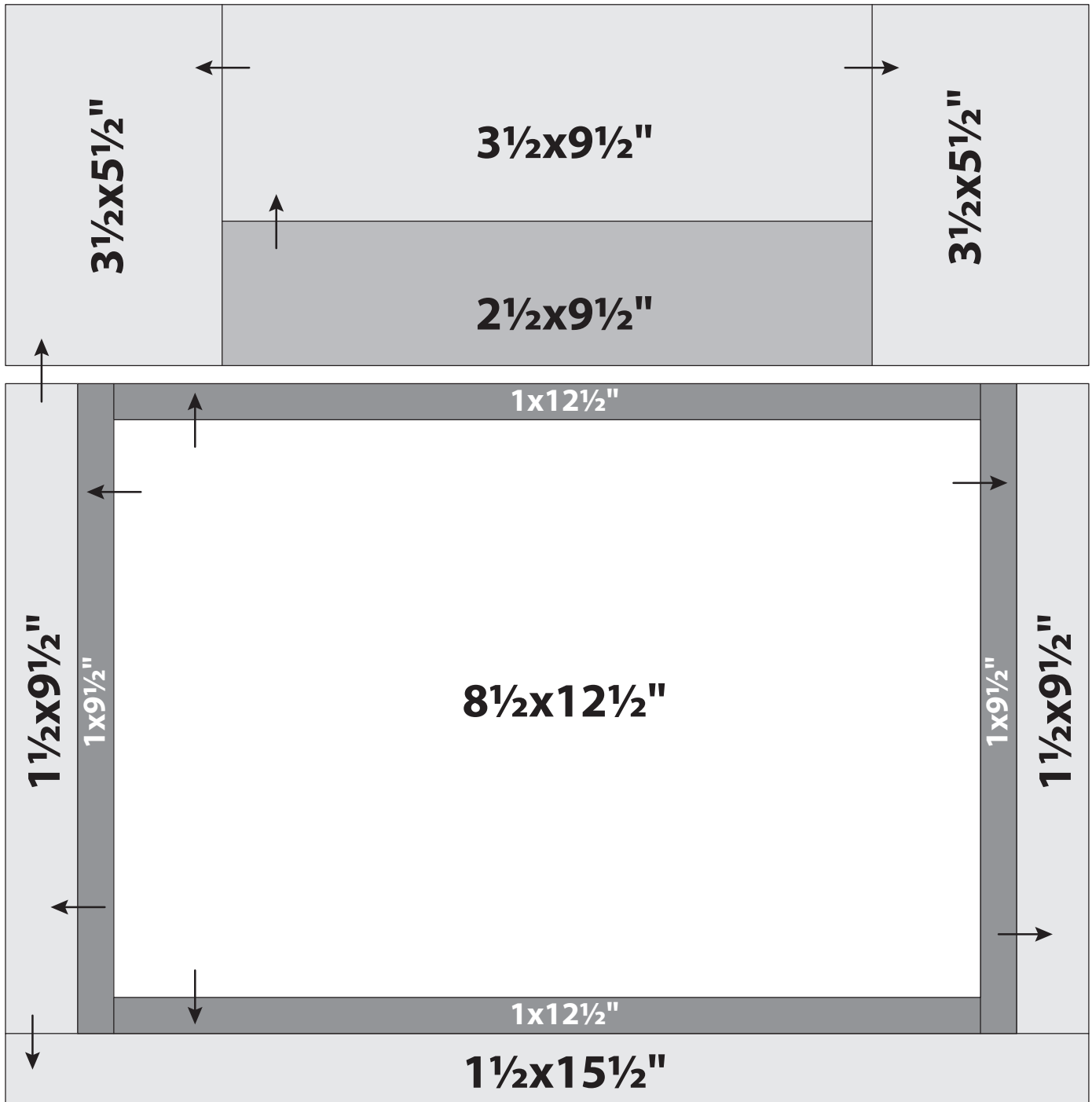
- Sew the 2½x9½" Center strip to the bottom of the 3½x9½" Border strip; press toward the border strip.
- Sew a 3½x5½" Border rectangle to each side of the center/ border strip assembly.

Finish the Block

- Sew the upper assembly to the lower block assembly, press toward the upper assembly.
- The Quilt Block measures 15½x15½".

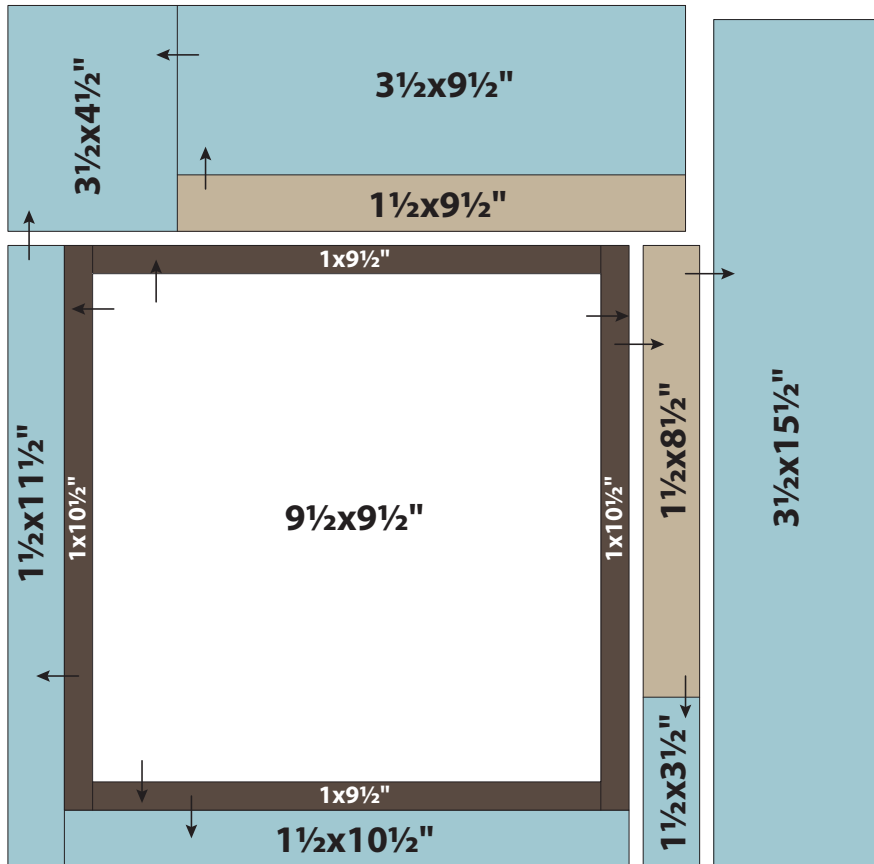

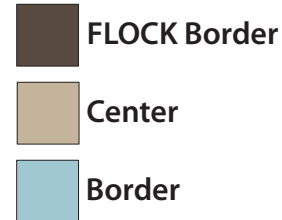
9x9" FLOCK Block

FLOCK Border (2x42")

- Cut two 1x10 1/2" strips and two 1x9 1/2" strips

Center (2x42")

- Cut one 1 1/2x9 1/2" strip and one 1 1/2x8 1/2" strip

Border (6x42")

- Cut one 3 1/2x15 1/2" strip, one 3 1/2x9 1/2" strip, and one 3 1/2x4 1/2" rectangle
- Cut one 1 1/2x11 1/2" strip, one 1 1/2x10 1/2" strip, and one 1 1/2x3 1/2" strip

FLOCK Block used for the 9x9" setting:

- Greater Roadrunner

Piecing

Note: Based on the orientation of the FLOCK block in the setting, 'sides,' 'top and bottom,' 'right,' and 'left' labels from the pattern may not correspond with your block. Follow the *block piecing diagram* and your shorthand notes from Step 3, page 4 carefully.

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Lower Left Borders

- Sew the 1x9 1/2" FLOCK Border strips to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x10 1/2" FLOCK Border strips to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 10 1/2x10 1/2".
- Sew the 1 1/2x10 1/2" Border strip to the bottom of the block.
- Sew the 1 1/2x11 1/2" Border strip to the left side of the block. Set aside.

- Sew the 1 1/2x3 1/2" Border strip the bottom of the 1 1/2x8 1/2" Center strip as shown; press toward the border strip.

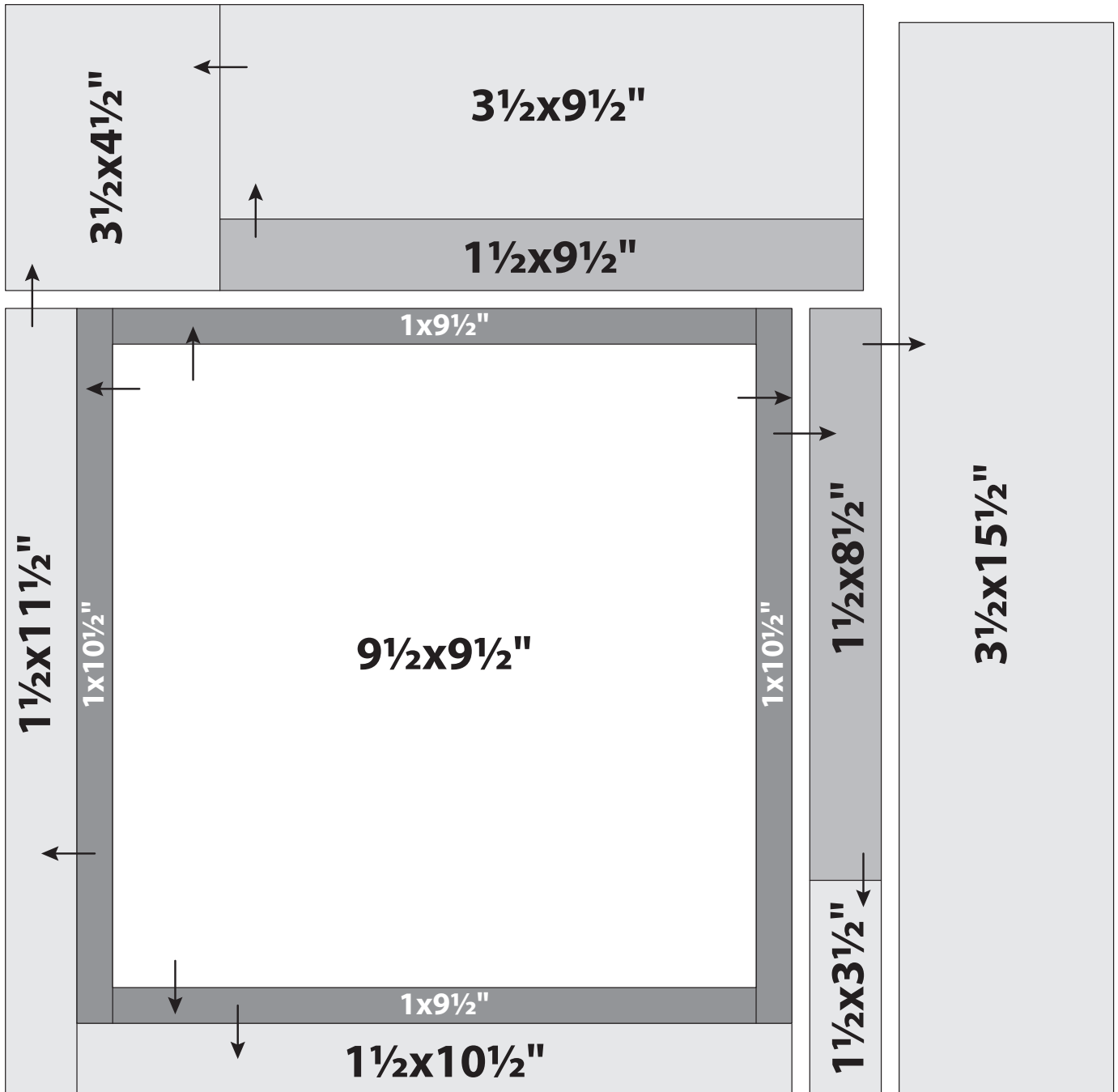
- Sew the border/center strip to the right side of the block.

Sew Upper Left Borders and Finish the Block

- Sew the 1 1/2x9 1/2" Center strip to the bottom of the 3 1/2x9 1/2" Border strip; press toward the border strip.
- Sew the 3 1/2x4 1/2" Border rectangle to the left of the border/center strip set.
- Sew the upper border assembly to the top of the block.
- Sew the 3 1/2x15 1/2" Border strip to the right side of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15 1/2x15 1/2".

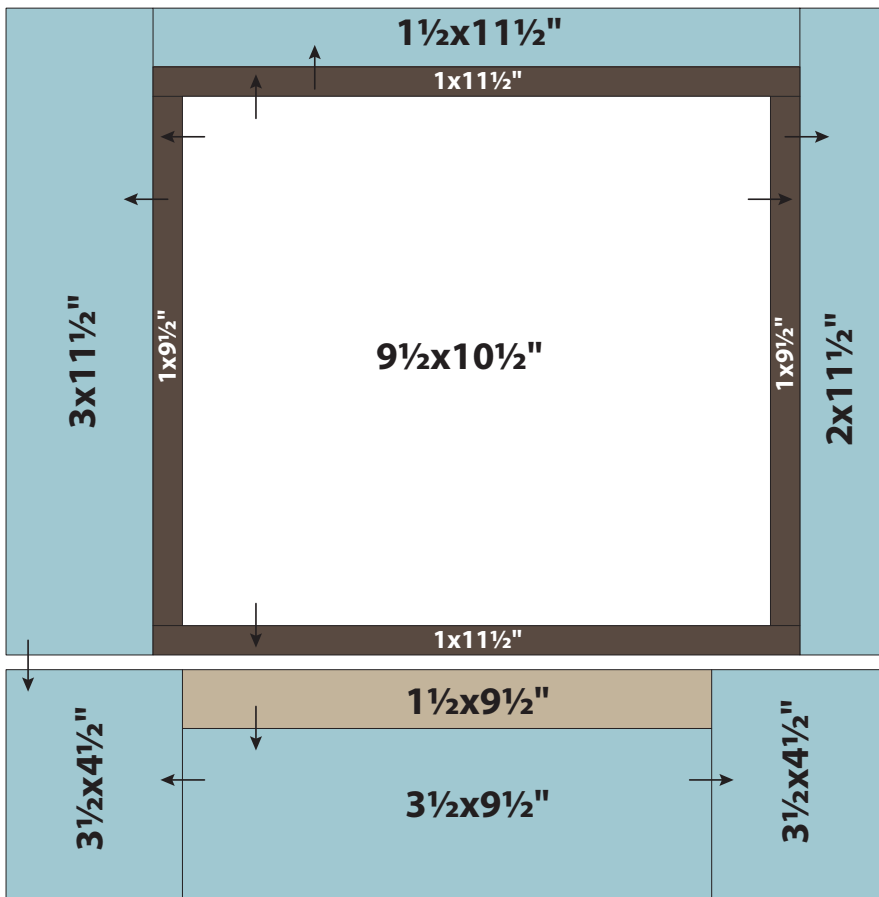

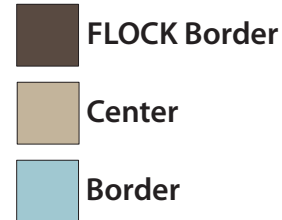

- Cut one 1½x9½" strip

- Cut one 3x11½" strip, one 2x11½" strip, and one 1½x11½" strip

FLOCK Block used for the 9x10"

setting:

- Wood Duck

Piecing

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Upper Borders

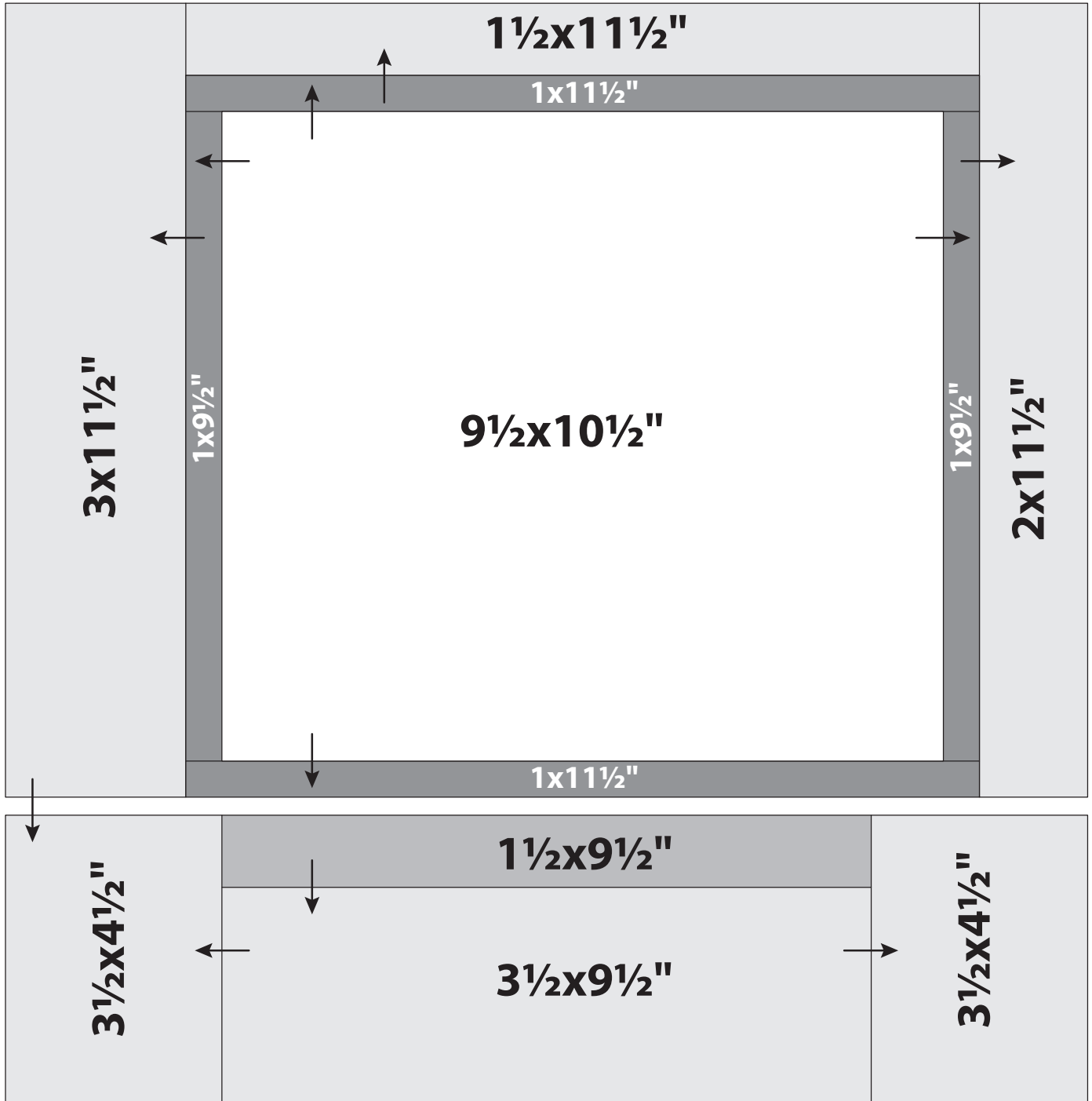
- Sew the 1x9½" FLOCK Border strips to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew the 1x11½" FLOCK Border strips to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 10½x11½".
- Sew the 1½x11½" Border strip to the top of the block.
- Sew the 3x11½" Border strip to the left side of the block, and sew the 2x11½" Border strip to the right side of the block.

Sew the Lower Borders and Finish the Block

- Sew the 1½x9½" Center strip to the top of the 3½x9½" Border strip; press toward the border strip.
- Sew a 3½x4½" Border rectangle to each side of the border/center strip set.
- Sew the border assembly to the bottom of the block; press toward the border assembly.
- The Quilt Block measures 15½x15½".

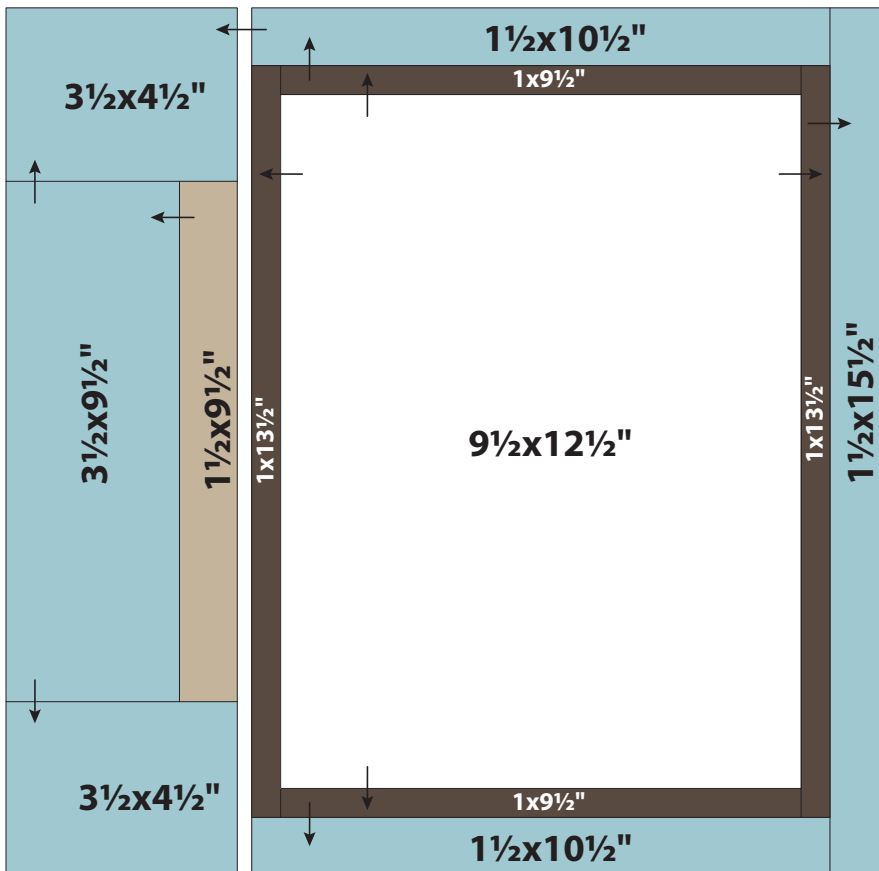

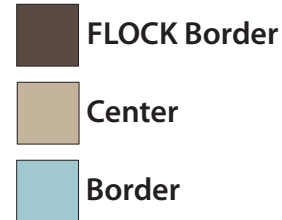

FLOCK Border (3x42")

- Cut two 1x13 1/2" strips and two 1x9 1/2" strips

Center (2x42")

- Cut one 1 1/2x9 1/2" strip

Border (6x42")

- Cut one 3 1/2x9 1/2" strip and two 3 1/2x4 1/2" rectangles
- Cut one 1 1/2x15 1/2" strip and two 1 1/2x10 1/2" strips

FLOCK Block used for the 9x12"

setting:

- Brown Pelican

Piecing

Note: Based on the orientation of the FLOCK block in the setting, 'sides,' 'top and bottom,' 'right,' and 'left' labels from the pattern may not correspond with your block. Follow the **block piecing diagram** and your shorthand notes from Step 3, page 4 carefully.

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Right Side

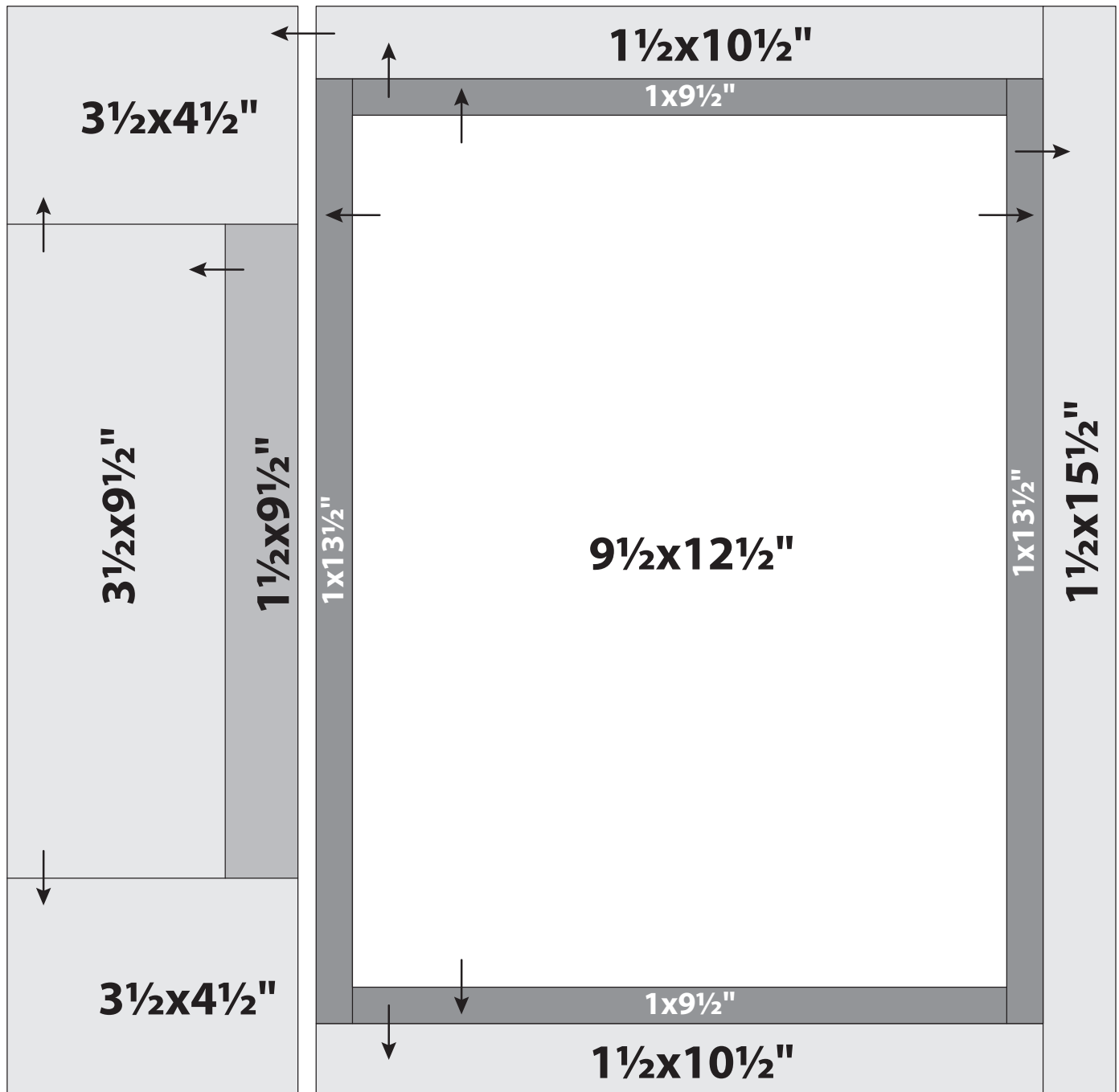
- Sew a 1x9 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x13 1/2" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- **The block with FLOCK borders measures 10 1/2x13 1/2".**
- Sew a 1 1/2x10 1/2" Border strip to the top and bottom of the block.
- Sew the 1 1/2x15 1/2" Border strip to the right side of the block.

Sew Left Borders and Finish the Block

- Sew the 1 1/2x9 1/2" Center strip to the right of the 3 1/2x9 1/2" Border strip; press toward the border strip.
- Sew a 3 1/2x4 1/2" Border rectangle to the top and the bottom of the border/center strip set.
- Sew the border assembly to the left of the block; press toward the border assembly.
- The Quilt Block measures 15 1/2x15 1/2".

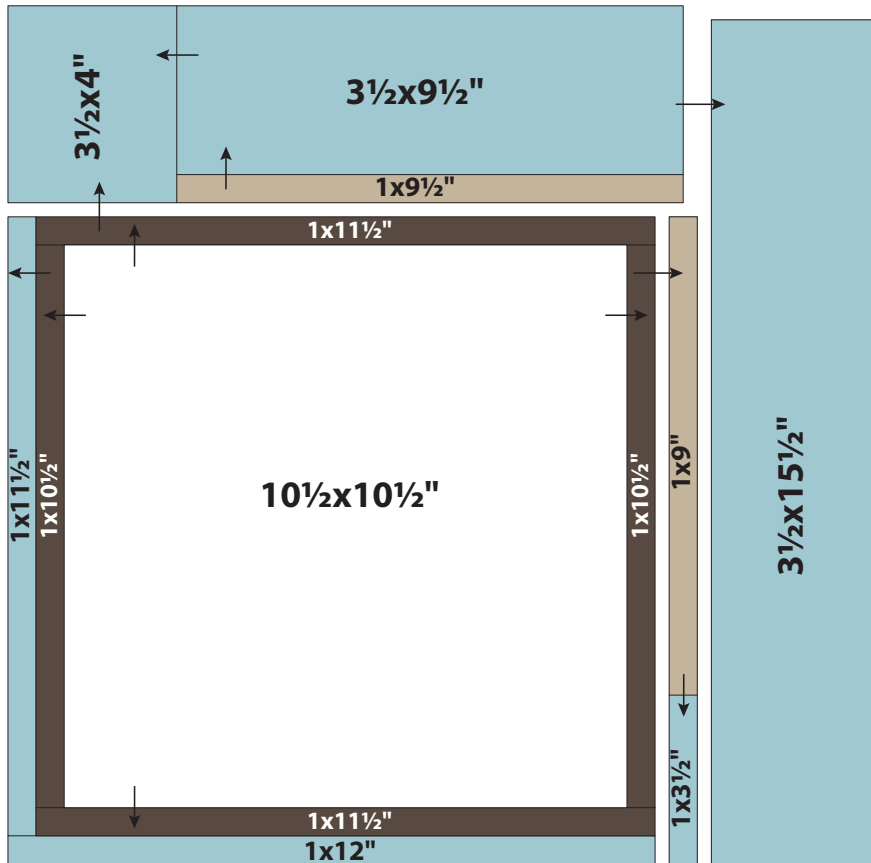

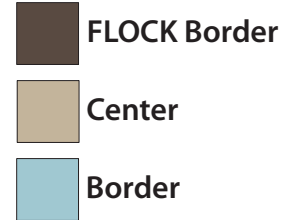

FLOCK Border (3x42")

- Cut two 1x11½" strips and two 1x10½" strips

Center (2x42")

- Cut one 1x9½" strip and one 1x9" strip

Border (6x42")

- Cut one 3½x15½" strip, one 3½x9½" strip, one 3½x4" rectangle, and one 1x3½" strip
- Cut one 1x12" strip and one 1x11½" strip

FLOCK Blocks used for the 10x10" setting:

- Northern Cardinal
- Rhode Island Red
- Snowy Owl

Piecing

Note: Based on the orientation of the FLOCK block in the setting, 'sides,' 'top and bottom,' 'right,' and 'left' labels from the pattern may not correspond with your block. Follow the **block piecing diagram** and your shorthand notes from Step 3, page 4 carefully.

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders and Inner Border Strip

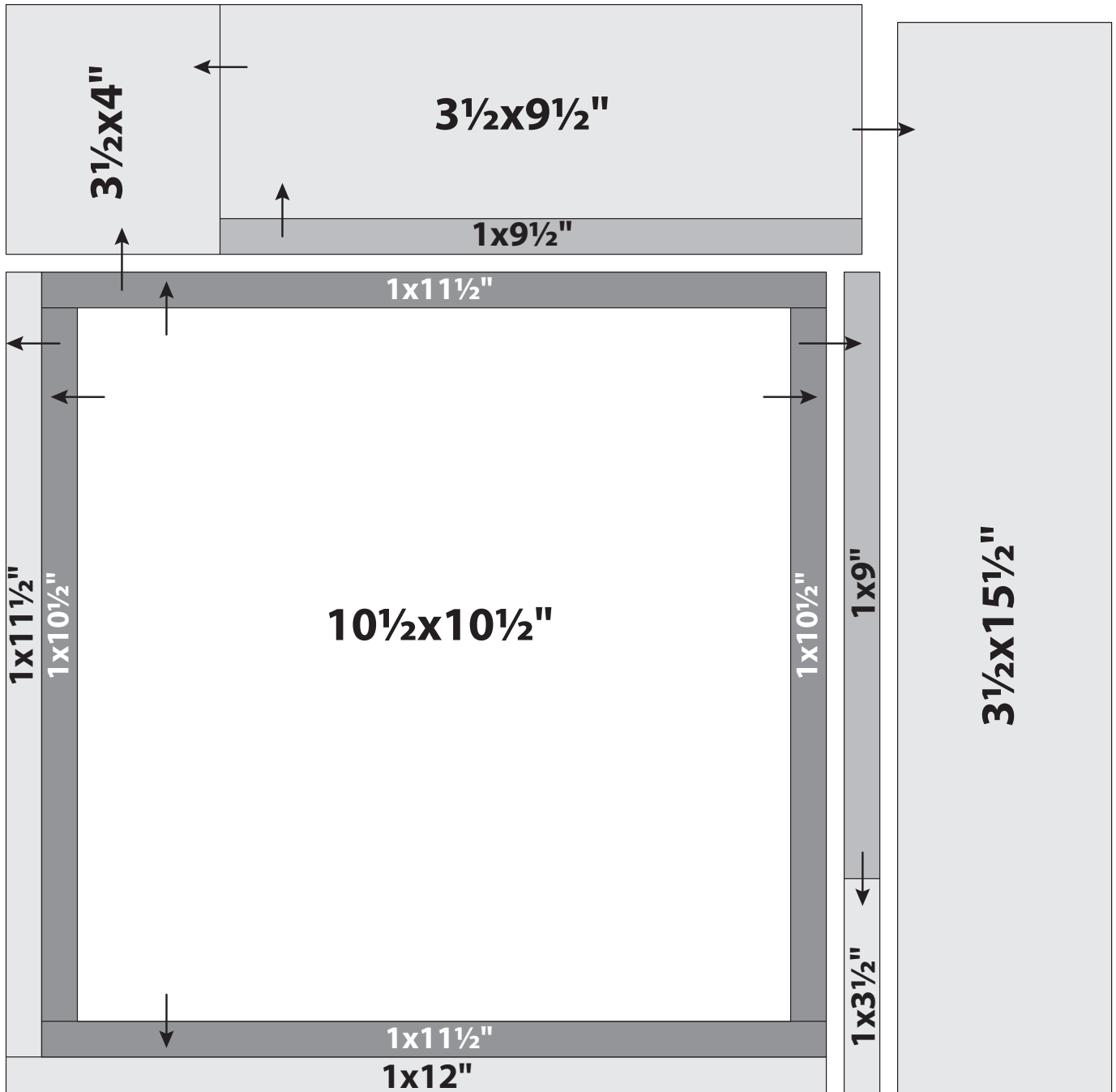
- Sew a 1x10½" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block.
- Sew a 1x11½" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 11½x11½".
- Sew the 1x11½" Border strip to the left of the block.
- Sew the 1x12" Border strip to the bottom of the block. Set aside.
- Sew the 1x3½" Border strip to the bottom of the 1x9" Center strip; press toward the border strip.
- Sew the block/center strip to the right side of the block.

Sew Upper Borders and Finish the Block

- Sew the 1x9½" Center strip to the bottom of the 3½x9½" Border strip; press toward the border strip.
- Sew the 3½x4" Border rectangle to the left of the border/center strip set.
- Sew the border assembly to the top of the block.
- Sew the 3½x15½" Border strip to the right side of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15½x15½".

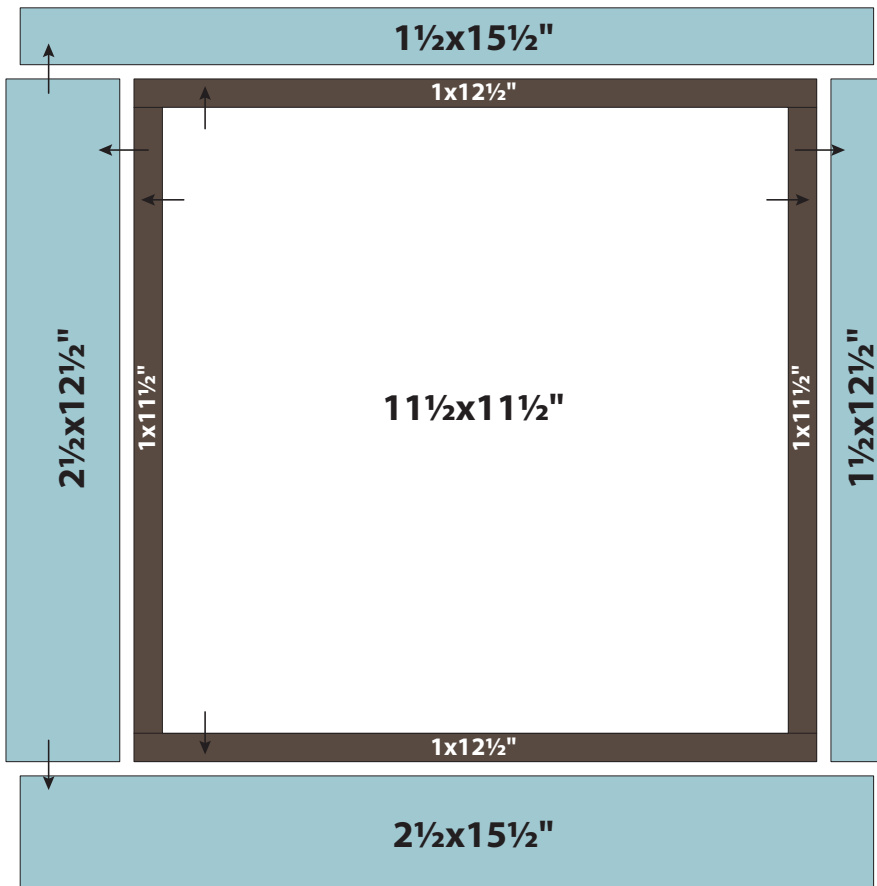

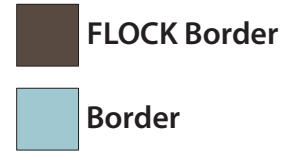

- Cut two 1x12½" strips and two 1x11½" strips

Border (5x42")

- Cut one 2½x15½" strip and one 2½x12½" strip
- Cut one 1½x15½" strip and one 1½x12½" strip

FLOCK Block used for the 11x11"

setting:

- Bald Eagle

Piecing

Note: Based on the orientation of the FLOCK block in the setting, 'sides,' 'top and bottom,' 'right,' and 'left' labels from the pattern may not correspond with your block. Follow the **block piecing diagram** and your shorthand notes from Step 3, page 4 carefully.

Important:

- Arrange the cut pieces on your work table following the diagram
- Unless otherwise instructed, press the seam toward the new element as it is added

Sew the FLOCK Borders

- Sew a 1x11½" FLOCK Border strip to each side of the FLOCK Block
- Sew a 1x12½" FLOCK Border strip to the top and bottom of the FLOCK Block.
- The block with FLOCK borders measures 12½x12½".

Finish the Block

- Sew the 2½x12½" Border strip to the left side of the block and the 1½x12½" Border strip to the right side of the block.
- Sew the 1½x15½" Border strip to the top of the block and the 2½x15½" Border strip to the bottom of the block.
- The Quilt Block measures 15½x15½".
